

Caroline C. Grant's Will

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In the name of God Amen. I Caroline C. Grant, wife of ~~Brigham~~ Grant of Dallas County and State of Alabama being weak in body but of sound mind and disposing memory, do make this my last Will and Testament as follows: Whereas I am entitled to an undivided interest in the Estate of David McCord and Margra-et McCord, my Father and Mother late of said County and of my Brother Alison McCord dec'd also late of said County Mississippi. I give and bequeath one half of my part, share or interest of all the personal and perishable property and assets of said Estates when ascertained to Dr Hugh W Grant my husband I give and bequeath to my niece Mary Eliza Brown, the other half of said Estate, to which I am entitled, to be held and bodily heirs for ever and to be held in Trust for the special and separate use and behoof by a Trustee appointed by the Court for that purpose; and should she die with out leaving heirs of her body lawfully surviving then her property, to go to her Brother David Alexander or his heirs (Except however, that the said Hugh W Grant and the said Eliza Brown, shall each out of their respective shares, pay to David Alexander Brown, the Brother of Mary Eliza three thousand Dollars each I also give and bequeath to the said David Alexander Brown my Coniage Bonds.
