all my land being the west half of Section of T^{wp} 19. Township
No 14 in range N. 12 - also all of the money I have at the
time and on 1822
all of the rest and residue of my goods and Chattels to be
Equally divided between my four daughters Judith Fulch, Penelope
Woods, Delitha Muller, and Anna Porters and my Son
Peter Woods after all just demands are paid. I nominate constitute
and appoint Peter Portier and Peter Woods my executors in this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other and former will
by me at any time heretofore made
