persons who thereby and thereof agreed to acquit also for me and in my
name to appear in my person to represent in all and every Court
or Courts or other place as demanded or required in any suit
or action also to sell transfer or assign any note or notes in my
favour also sell and make title by deed assignment or otherwise of
any lot or parcels of land in the Town of Cahaba and estate of
Alabama or any lands elsewhere likewise attorney or attorneys
