mentioned named 2nd I constitute and appoint my beloved brother
Ebenezer Miles Executor to this my last will and testament with
full power & authority to do and perform all requisitions and
provisions herein after pointed out 3rd my will and desire is
that all my just debts be paid and the remainder of my estate
managed and conducted as herein after pointed out C. L. Myrick
and desire is that all the property that I may be possessed of
at my death both real & personal remain in the hands wife of
whom to use my children or, at her death or entremarrage it is
my desire that my executor should manage my estate in that
way manner in which he may think most to the interest of my
children at fully freely as if myself were present to act
for them. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and

seal and deliver the foregoing instrument to be his last will and testa-

thereto at the special request of the testator - and in the presence of
John Miles and John Browning the other two subscribing witness
who signed the same in the presence of the testator and in the presence
of each other sworn to and subscribed this 10th day October 1825.
