It is also my Will and desire that the real estate that may be allotted by said division to my beloved wife Polly Phillips shall include the Mansion House in which I now dwell, the curtilage thereof and a suitable quantity of my lands adjoining the same for cultivation; to hold the said real estate for and during the term of her natural life or widowhood, and after her marriage with the consent of my Executors or a majority of them; and it is further my Will and desire that the share or dividend that may be allotted by said division to my different daughters shall vest absolutely in them and their respective heirs of their bodies forever. It is also my Will and desire that the division and distribution of my estate above mentioned be made by my Executors and Executors or by commissioners appointed by the orphans Court. My Son in law William Blewins in right of his wife Matilda has received from me in cash and property to the amount of two thousand nine hundred and fifty dollars. My Son William S Phillips has received from me in cash and property twenty five hundred dollars. My Son Francis M Phillips has received from me in cash and property to the amount of six thousand and ninety seven dollars, and My Son in law William Johnson has received from me in cash and property in right of his wife Lemuel to the amount of twenty four hundred and sixty three dollars. Which several amounts are to be deducted from their respective shares or dividends of my estate but no interest is to be charged on the said several amounts. I do hereby nominate and appoint my well beloved wife Polly Phillips my Executrix and my Son in law William Blewins and my Sons William S Phillips, Francis M Phillips, George H C Phillips and my Son in law William Johnson Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby revoke and cancel all former Wills and Testaments by me made. I testify whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of September A.D. 1834. Signed, sealed and published by the Testator. Geo Phillips (Sole) in our presence as and for his last Will and Testament. Who at his death and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses of the same. John L Watson, Abram S Pope, Samuel S Shaddock. I the said George Phillips do hereby make and ordain the following as and to my last Will and Testament. That my Executors or a majority of them may lawfully sell and grant such part or parts of my real estate

as they, being or a majority of them may think it advisable to dispose of either at private or public sales and the proceeds of such sale shall be divided and distributed according to the provisions of the main body of my will given under my hand and seal this tenth day of September 1834.

I hereby constitute my father Thomas Brown and my Father in law Benjamin Jarver my whole and sole Executors with full power and authority to act and do all things that may be calculated to promote the comfort and interest of my then wife and children in and about the premises and in case of the death or inability to act of either of my Executors I hereby appoint my Brother William Brown in place of my father and Benjamin Jarver in place
