George I. Hull's Will

The State of Alabama, Chatham County, In view of the imminence
 of life and of my approaching dissolution, being much
 debilitated with old age and weakness, I hereby provide
 for the comfort and subsistence of my much beloved
 children - hereinafter after named - I George I. Hull do hereby
 make known and declare that my last will and testament
 is in the first place I leave to my daughter Elizabeth I. Hull
 and all the day long she has, or may hereafter have by my
 son William W. I. Hull the following described tracts, to-wit:
 of Land viz. the West half of the A & B quarter of Section Six
 in Township Section of Range Twelve containing eighty two
 & 33 per. Acres the East half of the North East quarter of Section
 Six in Township Section of Range Twelve containing eighty
 two & 33 per. Acres the East East half of the North West quarter
 of Section five in Township Section of Range Twelve containing
 eight & 8 per. Acres the West half of the North West quarter of
 Section five in Township Section of Range Twelve containing
 eight & 8 per. Acres in the Cherokee Land district, also one
 eighth part of same Washington. In the second place, I
 will to my son Donaldson Hull during his natural life and
 afterwards to his offspring of the same, being my last and
 ultimate bequest to him as my legitimate children and heirs
 being the following described tracts or parcels of Land viz. the East

Negro woman named Eliza In the 2nd place I will to my daughter Maria
Elizabeth during her natural life and after her death to her children if
she leaves any at her death Whichever to want back to my legal
heirs and then offspring the following described negroes One
man named Miles One woman named Jane and her infant
Child named Edward In the 3rd place I will to my daughter
Ann Richmond and her offspring if she has any at her death
Whichever to want back to my legal heirs and then offspring
the following described negroes One man named Jack One
boy named Edward Edmund In the 4th place I will to my son
Sam Hiram Kimball the sum of five Dollars and in the
next place I will to my son William B Hall the sum of
five Dollars In the last place I hereby make known that it
is my will that the negroes at above named are not to
be taken off from my farm until my wife is dead and
for the faithful execution of this my last will and testament I
hereby appoint my sons Miles W B Hall and Jonathan Lewis
my Executors In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this the thirtieth day of October A D 1842
