Jacob Stewart Will

The State of Alabama Dallas County In the Name of God
Amen. I Jacob Stewart of the County and State aforesaid
do hereby make and declare this my Last Will and
Testament in the Manner and form following (that is to
say) First I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty
God, hoping and believing in a Resurrection of my body by the
mighty and mediation of Jesus Christ, And my body
commit to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my
Executor herein after named.

1st I desire that all the personal estate of my property except my slaves
be immediately sold after my decease, and also all my Land Estate
Lying in the County & State aforesaid, be sold, and out of the money arising
therefrom all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid.
2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved Mother Catherine Wells the
sum of fifty dollars, if shee be now a living. 3rd I give and bequeath unto
my Mother John Ward the sume of fiftie dollars.
4th I also give and bequeath unto my Sister Jane Gibson the sume of five
Dollars; 5th I also give and bequeath unto my Sister Margaret Hayes
the sume of five dollars. 6th I also give and bequeath unto my half Sister
Caster More the sume of five dollars. 7th I also give and bequeath
unto the two & half heirs of my half Sister Elizabeth More the sume of five dollars;
8th I also give and bequeath unto my half Sister Catherine Lewis the sume of
five dollars. 9th I also give and bequeath unto Mary McMillan
my step Sister the sume of fiftie dollars; 10th I also give and bequeath
unto the two & half heirs of Hugh McMillan my Wifes Brother the sume
of five dollars; 11th I also hereby declare it to be my
will and desire if not contrary to the Laws by the State of Oklahoma
to emancipate and give my slave from Slavery all my slaves here
in who are named. Go H C Sturtevant, Henry J. McMillan,
Eddies, Mary Anne McMillan, Abby McMillan, Martha
Lewis, Samuels, Margaret McMillan, and the future increase of the
said females all of said slaves I wish my Executors immediately
that my slaves & he have them carried for sent off to a free state
either to the State of Oklahoma or to California, and all the expenses
for sending said slaves to either place paid out of any money of my estate
12th Also the Residue of my Money should there be any left after paying
all my just debts & funeral expenses and other expenses that may
be incurred by my Executors in the execution of this my last
Will and Testament, to be equally divided among said slaves
13th I also give and bequeath unto each of my Executors the sum
of five hundred dollars extra of their compensation above them by
Dollars. 14th And Lastly; I do hereby constitute and appoint
my friends James Gilmer H. and Archibald Fair, Executors
of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other former
Wills or testaments by me made. I do witness whereof I have
signed to it my name and affixed my seal this twenty eighth day
of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & forty two

Thomas Arnold's Will

and Testament of Thomas Arnold, I Considring the
Uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind
and memory do make, and Publish this my last Will
and Testament in manner and form following that is
to say & First I bequeath my soul to God who gave it
Secondly I will that immediately after my decease my property
be sold Enough of my personal property to pay all my just
debts and funeral expenses. Thirdly I will that my
Beloved wife Mary Arnold shall have all my estate
both Real and Personal during her natural life, and
after her death I give it to my children herein after
named, I give to my Daughter Anne H. Franklin and her
heirs for ever all the land belonging to me which land
I believe is worth something more than the lands I
have given to my other children, but it is my will that
they should have it for the trouble and expense the said
Anne H. Franklin has had and will have with me my
wife, and several other slaves belonging to me
and it is my will that said slaves be sustained by said
Anne H. Franklin after the death of my self and wife.
the distribution that I have heretofore made among my
children I think to be equal and just. I will that
immediately after the death of my wife, Mary my executors
proceed to make an equal division of my personal property
With the following exception and first my daughter
Temperance Ross and family have had the use of three
Hundred Dollars more than I have given to the rest of my
children it is my will that said three hundred dollars be
included in their part of the division of my personal Estate
and secondly I give two hundred pounds to my daughter
Sarah Ross and the lawful children of her body
one half the part of my personal Estate during the natural
