James C. Campbell Will
I James C. Campbell of Dallas County State of Alabama
being indisposed in bodily health but of sound and disposing
mind and memory calling to mind the frailty and uncertainty
of human life and being desirous of settling my worldly
affairs, and wishing how the Estates with which it has
pleased God to bless me shall be disposed of after my
decease, while I have strength and capacity so to do, make
and publish this my last Will and Testament.
Merely Revoking and Making Null and Void all other
last Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made.
First I Command my immortal Soul to Him Who gave it,
and my body to the Earth to be buried with little expense
and cost of Station by my Executors, herein after named
and as to my Worldly Estate and all the Property real personal
or mixed of which I may die seized, and disposed of to
which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease I
do give bequeath and dispose thereof in the Manner following.
I purport my Will is that all my just debts and funeral
Expenses shall by my Executors herein after named be paid
out of my Estate as soon after my decease as shall by them
be found convenient. Then I give devise and bequeath
to my beloved Wife Mary Campbell all my house hold
and Kitchen Furniture together with the Stock Very Horses
Mules Waggon Cattle Hogs and provisions on hand &c.

The Land on which I now live near New Lewis Dallas Co. being forty
acres more or less with the house and appurtenances thereunto belonging
with the privilege of disposing of said land by and with the Consent of
my Executors hereafter mentioned to have and to hold the same to his
the said Mary Campbell's Natural life and after his decease to be
divided among my lawful heirs. I then I give and bequeath to my
daughter Martha B. Nelson the following Negroes with their Natural
increase. Jack Hannah Chisick Charity Cherry (which Negroes have
been put in his possession to have and to hold the same to the said
Martha B. Nelson his heirs and assigns to him and their use and behoof
forever. I then I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Ann, Miradith
the following Negroes with their Natural increase Delilah, Tim, Luisa,
Ellen, Dohiel, Silas, Gabriel to have and to hold the same to
the said Mary Ann, Miradith his heirs and assigns to her and their
use and behoof for ever. I then I give and bequeath to my
daughter Emmanuella Campbell the following Negroes with their Natural
increase. Fada, Louisa, Silas, Maria, Esther to have and to hold the same to
the said Emmanuella Campbell her heirs and assigns to her and their use
and behoof for ever. I then I give and bequeath to my daughter
Lucan Campbell the following Negroes with their Natural increase
Harriet, Sena, Oscar, Sophia, Henry, Anna, Jack to have and to
hold the same to the said Lucan Campbell his heirs and assigns
to him and their use and behoof for ever. I then I do further give
and bequeath to my dear Wife Mary Campbell the remainder of my
Negroes with their Natural increase to have and to hold the same
to her the said Mary Campbell during her Natural life and
after her decease to be divided among all my Children or their
Surviving Children representing their Parents. I then I do further declare
it to be my Will that should there be any diminution by death
or otherwise in the Number of Negroes Willed to my daughters, Susan
= Anna Susan before they are put in possession of said Negroes
which shall be when they become of age or Mary until which
time said Negroes shall be kept together with the Negroes I have
hereafter left to my Wife Mary Campbell under the Control of
my Wife and Executors my Daughter, Emmanuella & Susan to be sup-
-ported by them until their property is delivered to them the same
domination shall be supplied from the Negroes or their Natural
increase left to my Wife the said Mary Campbell before the
general division of property to her to take. I then I do further
give and bequeath to my dear Wife Mary Campbell the remainder
of my Negroes with their Natural increase to have and to hold the
same to her the said Mary Campbell during her Natural life
and after her decease to be divided equally among all my
Children or their Surviving Children representing their Parents.
Lastly I do Nominate and appoint my Sons John W
Campbell and James M Campbell to be the Executors

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 10 of this my last Will & Testament and after my decease
 to take in possession all the property within the my Wife and little
 all my last Wills - out of said property in the manner they may
 think meet to the benefit of my Estate - and the remainder to be
 given up to my Wife Mary Campbell for her use during her natural
 life. In Testimony whereof I the said James C Campbell have
 to this my last Will and Testament contained in one sheet of paper
 subscribed my name and affixed my seal this eighth day of April
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four
 being in presence of James C Campbell, Test
 J. M. Colburn, Wm M. Christian, Rufell Watson

I do further declare it to be my Will that the tract of Land
 that I own known as the Hobbs Land first in Dallas County
 and in Wilcox Co also a tract of Land in Oklahoma Co
 Mississippi the said whereof I recently may think best to
 hold and the proceeds legally divided among my lawful heirs
 the day and date above written James C Campbell
 signed in presence of us who signed our names in the presence of
 the Testator & in presence of each other J. M. Colburn
