To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting,
Whereas Robert Greer Junior of Dallas County Alabama
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States
a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Cahaba in Alabama
whenever it appears that full payment has been made by the said Robert
Greer Junior according to the provisions of the act of Congress of
the 24 of April 1820, entitled an act making further provision for the
sale of the Public Lands for the West half of the South West quar-
ter of Section fourteen in Township fourteen of Range nine
in Cahaba District State of Alabama containing eighty
acres according to the official plat of the Survey of the
said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Survey-
or General, which said tract has been purchased by the said
Robert Greer Junior.

Now known to the United States of America
in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress in such cases made and provided have
given and granted and by these presents do give and grant
unto the said Robert Greer Junior the said tract
above described to have and to hold the same together
with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurten-
ances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the
said Robert Greer Junior and his heirs, executors
assigns forever.

Monroe, President of the United States of Amer-
ica, have caused these letters to be made &c &c and
the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one and of the
