and State of South Carolina Planter being in perfect health mind  
and memory thanks be to God do make and ordain this my last  
will & Testament wrote with my own hand in manner & form  
following. I do will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Greening  
the following three negroes Sarah her son Billy & daughter Kelley  
horse of chair Bed of furniture to her & to her heirs and assigns forever  
Item - I will & bequeath to my said wife followed White Harrold  
Greening Eldridge Simpson Greening and John James Greening  
when either marries or arrives to age of twenty one years old, three negroes  
between the age of twelve & twenty years, good Horse & Saddle three  
cows of calves Bed of furniture to each. Item - I will & bequeath  
unto my son Rufus Williams Greening four negroes between the age  
of twelve & twenty years old two of which negroes Parish to boys  
and bound with them to what trade he may best be fit at the age of  
sixteen, and be his at twenty one years old which will be the  
time of his freedom good Horse & Saddle three cows of calves Bed of  
furniture all to be delivered at the time he is twenty one years old  
or married. Item - I will & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Ann  
Greening when she marries or arrives at the age of eighteen years old  
three negroes between twelve & twenty years old a good horse three cows  
of calves Bed of furniture. Item - I will & bequeath to my daughter  
Mary Whitehead Greening when she arrives to the age of fifteen  
years old three negroes between twelve and twenty years old a good  
Horse three cows of calves Bed of furniture. Item I will & bequeath  
unto my daughter Amanda Polson Greening three negroes between  
the age of twelve & twenty years old, horse three cows feathers Bed  
of furniture. Item it is my will & desire that our said my wife should  
be pregnant at the time of my death that the child shall share  
equally with Wade Eldridge John Elizabeth Mary & Amanda  
Greening both of real & personal property. Item it is my will  
that all my lands in this State be sold for the purpose of paying my  
debts and that a tract at the decisions of my executors be bought  
for the use of my family and to work my negroes on until my  
daughter Mary Whitehead Greening becomes fifteen years old  
then those that have not received their Legacy as above named to  
receive it and the remainder to be equally divided amongst my  
children without a sale of the personal property. Item should  
my wife marry it is my will that she receive Sarah Billy &  
Kelley horse of chair Bed of furniture in Lieu of Dower.

Item - it is my desire should my Executors after settling my lands find it  
actually necessary to dispose of more property for the purpose of paying  
my just debts that they sell Martin a blacksmith Long Bob & wife  
Abigail - Item - My will is that my property be kept together for  
the supporting of my family and educating my children until any  
may marry them they may receive their Legacies and have no further  
disposition from the Estate until the final division when all the land  
must be sold and divided amongst my children equal - Lastly  
I do will ordain constitute my beloved wife Mary Greening Executrix  
during her widow hood, Wade H Greening and Clark Taylor in Georgia my  
lawful Executors of this my last will & testament I in witness whereof  
I set my hand and seal this the seventeenth day of October in the year of  
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen John Greening <sup>Sealed</sup>

to hold forever also I give and devise to my oldest son William Waugh  
Any waggon & gear belonging to have also I give and devise to my old  
daughter Margaret my second daughter Jean my third daughter Eliza  
- & to the my fourth daughter Susan of my son Samuel twenty five cents each  
to be paid to them by my Executors after my death - Also give and devise  
to all my grand sons that is called John ten dollars except the son of my  
daughter Sarah Marrow and to him I give and devise one cow of calf  
to be paid by my Executors after my death - also I give and devise all my  
other property to be equally divided between my well beloved wife Jean  
Waugh & Rosina Waugh my youngest daughter and I do hereby appoint  
David Marrow of William Waugh Executor of this my last Will  
and Testament Signed sealed published and declared by the said  
testator as for his last will & testament in presence of us who are
