and State of South Carolina Planter being in perfect health mind
and memory thanks be to God do make and ordain this my last
will & testament wrote with my own hand in manner of form
following I do will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Greening
the following three negroes Sarah, her Son Puly & daughter Melley
horse & chairs Bed & furniture to her & to her heirs and assigns forever
Item - I will & bequeath to my sons as follows Wade Harwood
Greening Eldridge Simpson Greening and John James Greening
when either marries or arrives to age of twenty one years old three negroes
between the age of twelve & twenty years good Horse & saddle three
cows & calves Bed & furniture to each. Item - I will & bequeath
unto my son Rufus Williams Greening four negroes between the age
of twelve & twenty years old two of which negroes I wish to buy
and bond with him to what trade he may best like at the age of
seventeen and be his at twenty one years old which will be the
time of his freedom good Horse & saddle three cows & calves Bed &
furniture all to be delivered at the time he is twenty one years old
or marries. Item - I will & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Ann
Greening when she marries or arrives at the age of eighteen years old
three negroes between twelve & twenty years old a good horse three cows
& calves Bed & furniture Item - I will & bequeath to my daughter
Mary Whitehead Greening when she arrives to the age of fifteen
years old three negroes between twelve and twenty years old a good
Horse three cows & calves Bed & furniture. Item I will & bequeath
unto my daughter Amanda Polu Greening three negroes between
the age of twelve & twenty years old, horse three cows & calves Bed
& furniture. Item it is my will & desire that in case my wife should
be pregnant at the time of my death that the child shall share
equally with Wade Eldridge John Elizabeth Mary & Amanda
Greening both of real & personal property. Item it is my will
that all my lands in this State be sold for the purpose of paying my
debts and that a tract at the discretion of my Executors be bought
for the use of my family and to work my negroes on until my
daughter Mary Whitehead Greening becomes fifteen years old
then those that have not received their Legacy as above named to
receive it and the remainder to be equally divided amongst my
children without a sale of the personal property. Item should
my wife marry it is my will that she receive Sarah Puly and
Melley horse & chair Bed & furniture in Lieu of Dower.

Item - it is my desire should my Executors after selling my lands find it actually necessary to dispose of more property for the purpose of paying my just debts that they sell Martin a Blacksmith Long Baldy wife Abigail - Item - My will is that my property be kept together for the supporting of my family and educating my children untill they may marry them they may receive their Legacies and have no further support from the Estate untill the final Division when all the land must be sold and divided amongst my children equal. Lastly I do will ordain constitute my beloved wife Mary Greening Executrix during her widowhood, Wade H Greening and Clark Taylor in Georgia my lawful Executors of this my last will & testament. In witness whereunto I set my hand and seal this the seventeenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and ~~thirteen~~ ^{fifteen} John Greening ~~test~~ signed sealed published declared in the presence of test James Claillett Robert H Brumley - I do hereby certify the within to be a true copy taken from the original and that it was proven in open court on the twenty fifth day of April Anno Domini 1817. by the oath of Robert H Brumley one of the subscribing witnesses thereto at same time qualified Mary Greening Executrix of Wade H Greening named Executor in said will. In the name of God Amen I John Waugh do make declare this my last will & testament in manner & form following First I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping and believing in a remission of my sins by the merit and mediation of Jesus Christ And my body I do commit to the earth to be buried in a christian and decent like manner by my friends and Executors herein after named And my worldly Estate I give and devise as follows First I give and devise to my well beloved wife Jean one half of the plant chosen & now left it being in Range nine & a half fifteen and section one to have & to hold forever and the other half of the above described section I give and bequeath to my youngest daughter Rosanna Waugh to have & to hold forever also I give and devise to my oldest son William Waugh my waggon & gear belonging to have - also I give and devise to my oldest daughter Margarette, my second daughter Jean my third daughter Elizabeth my fourth daughter Susan & my son Samuel twenty five cents each to be paid to them by my Executors after my death - Also give and devise to all my grand sons that is called John ten dollars except the son of my daughter Sarah Morrow and to him I give and devise one cow & calf to be paid by my Executors after my death - also I give and devise all my other property to be equally divided between my well beloved wife Rosanna Waugh & Rosanna Waugh my youngest daughter and I do hereby appoint David Morrow & William Waugh Executors of this my last will and Testament.
