County of Collier and State of Alabama do make and
declare this my last will and testament in manner and
form following Viz 1st After the payment of all my just
debts and funeral expenses I devise bequeath and grant
as follows 2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Julia
Cypher and her bodily heirs for their own use and
benefit all of the property hereunto bequeathed to her to wit
the negroes a boy and a Girl known by the name
of Sam & Caroline a horse two cows & calves and
other hogs and furniture which brings her upon
a piece with what my other children have hereunto

god I give and bequeath all the remaining part of
my Estate Real, personal and divisible to my chosen
namely my sons Wily I Sorel Seaborn I Sorel
John M Sorel James M Sorel and Thomas B
Sorel and my daughters Matilda Webb Sorel
Browning Rebecca Adams Mary Webb Talia
Casper Margaret Tyant and the bodily heirs of
Catharine Barnes late the wife of John B Barnes now
deceased to be divided among them equally subject however
to the justifications and Excisions following as regards
my sons Wily I and Seaborn I Sorel viz Wily I Sorel
to have an equal share after deducting what I have paid
for him to wit Five thousand eight hundred and forty
Dollars paid in the Santee Case & other Seaborn I Sorel
to have an equal share after deducting the amount I have
paid for him viz about Five thousand dollars The shares
of my daughters to go to them and the heirs of their bodies
and shall either of them die without bodily heirs then her
or their share to devolve and be equally divided amongst
her brothers and sisters or their legal heirs I hereby
revoke all other and former Wills by me heretofore made
lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my son James
M Sorel and my Son-in-law Henry Adams Executors of
this my last Will and testament In testimony Whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this Second day of
