paid part out of the first Monies that shall come into the
hands of my executors men after named. I desire further
that the property which I shall die possessed of shall be
left together with my real estate and personal property
for the purpose of paying my just debts if it be pos-
sible so to do. And in Consideration of the love and
affection which I bear and beg my beloved wife
William Watson I give and bequeath unto her the
said Estate of Watson all the property both real and
personal which I now have, during her Natural life, that
is to say; The West half of the North East quarter
Section Twenty one Township Eighteen and Range One
with all the buildings thereon and appurtenances thereto
belonging, it being all my real estate of personal
property. The following to M.C. all my black and
white Junction I his head of Cattle all my Stock hogs,
one School Horse and Cattle unto the following named persons
John and his three Children Henry, George and
Eliza & all the reputation of the term of my said wives
Natural life I desire and bequeath that above mentioned
real and personal Estate to my heirs which may be
(Joshua Watson) living upon the death of my said
wife and I the hereby nominate and appoint
Joshua Watson to be Executor of this My last Will
and Testament and I do signify him, before me, to be
and all former and other Wills and Will to me at any
time or times here before made and do hereby declare
these presents to be and contain my last Will and Testament
In witness whereof I the said Testator have to this day
set this written on two pages of one sheet of paper
to the first page thereof set my hand unto this the
second and last page thereof set my hand and seal.
