In the name of God Amen I Junda Lee of the State of
Alabama and County of Dallas being in good health and of
perfect minde thanks be given unto god Calling minde
shortly of my body and knowing that it is appointed
for all men made to die do make and ordaine this my last
Will and testament that is to say principally and first
of all give and command my soul into the hands of
Almighty god that goest into my body to come and to
be Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the
desiration of my friends and as touching such worldly Estate
wherewith it has pleased god to blesse me in this life
dismise and dispose of the same in the following
manner and form to wit First I give unto my wife
Pleasant Lee the following property to wit Thirteen Negroes
to wit namely Hanes her Partner Sam Martin Silna
Hannay Dami Dels a Caroline Harriet Minerva and
Rufus and also all of my Books and furniture and I also lend
unto my wife Pleasant Lee during her natural life time or
so long as she shall hold the following property to wit Ben David Richard
Gloria Blinda Millie Dame Robert July and lots and
also all of my Lands and Stock of all description and
Crop and personal now on hand and forming to wit
Second it is my will after the death or Marriage of my wife
Pleasant Lee that All my property which I have Lent to my
wife to be Sold by my executors to wit Ben gross and all
of my lands and Stock of all description the plantation
buildings and the crop and all the Revenue there on hand
the lands to be Sold and Credit on half to sale due at
the Expiration one year and the other half at the Expiration
of Two years and the balance of the property to be sold and
Credit of One year and it my will that the money arising
from the sale of the above named property to be divided equally
divided among all my grand Children when they arrive
to the age of Twenty one years that is to say that I wish my
executors to keep the money at interest in safe hands till the
time to the age of Twenty one years at which time I wish that
one to recover their part and the balance to remain in the
hands of My executors at Interest as before until the
second one arrives at the age of Twenty one years at which
time that one to receive its part and in like manner till the
whole arrives to the age of Twenty one years of "thine give
unto my daughter Elizabeth 10 of fifty Dollars in cash
and I also lend unto my daughter Elizabeth 10 of dozen
her natural life the following property to wit Two negroes
to wit Tilly & Abilley one girl Laborn as three beds &

furniture and one half dozen Seating chairs and of my
daughter Elizabeth Cox should have his or her's birth
of his body to serve me & give the above property to her
heir or heirs as the case may be and if my daughter
Should have no heirs born of her body then in that
case at her death the property to return to my Estate
Executor to be sold by them and the money divided
Especially among my grand Children. I further give unto
my daughter Nancy Lance the following property to wit
Your negroes to wit namely Hatch Jack Slippery & Ginny
three Beds Furniture one half dozen Seating chairs &
also fifty dollars in Cash. Fifth it is my will that my Executor
Should do sale. Two of my negroes to wit Redick and Easter
and pay all of my debts and all other Just debts Expences
the balance of the money to be given unto my wife for her
to have and dispose of agreeable to her will as follows.

Sixth it is also my will that all of my property that I have
not otherwise disposed of as also all moneys due and owing
unto me as well as all moneys on hand I give unto my
wife Pleasant Lee. Seventh and I constitute and appoint
Eaton Lee and Samuel Moore sole Executor of this
my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly
Rescind revoke and disannul all and every other
former wills and Executors by me in any wise before
named Wills and bequeathed ratified and confirmed
this and are other to be my last Will and Testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
Twenty seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and thirty three. Edmund Lee
Signed sealed and delivered by the said Edmund Lee as his last
Will and testament in the presence of us whom he presents and
in the presence of each other have countersigned to our
names. Allen Moore Nathl Kimbrough Bryan
Hail Burwell Kimbrough. The State of Alabama
Dallas County Personly appeared in open Court
Nathaniel Kimbrough one of the subscribing witnesses to
the foregoing Will who being duly sworn deposes and
Sith that he saw Edmund Lee sign seal and duly execute
said Will as and for his last will and testament that
said testator was of sound mind and disposing
memory at the time of executing the same and
that he the deponent Bryan Hail and Burwell
Kimbrough and Allen Moore signed the same as
Witness in presence of and at the request of said Testator
and of each other

I the State of South Carolina York District In the name
of God amonst Joseph Lawrence of the State and district
aforesaid I make my last will & dispensing mind to do
make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner &
form following &c h^t 1st I will & bequeath unto my son Allen the
 tract of Land & lot of John Tamm containing about one
 hundred acres more or less reference to the Conveyance to myself
 the boundaries thereof will fully appear to him & his heirs forever
 also One bed & furniture & one Cow & Calf & my negro girl named
 Diana & will her increase born after this day if Diana dies
 before Allen obtain the possession of her from me then her & all
 to be made up to him out of my Estate. 2nd I will & bequeath
 to my son Allen in Specie at least for the Support and Maintenance
 and a necessarie of my daughter Frances during the
 term of her natural life the following proposit to wit:
 Anaka her daughter Sarah & her Child & now at this time
 being a female & with the said negroes their future income
 both after this day & after the death of my said daughter the
 said negroes with their increase to be equally divided among
 amongst such child or children as shall be born to Frances man
 before living at the time of her death she & he are to take
 like them & their heirs forever and should my said daughter
 die without leaving such child or children alive at the
 time of death then the said negroes with their increase shall re-
 turn to my heirs at law & be equally divided amongst them &
 their heirs forever should another or his children or any of them
 die before possession possessed from me the value then of
 to be made up from my Estate under the same limitations
 and restrictions as Anaka then increases. 3rd I will also
 bequeath unto my wife Martha her Support and Maintenance
 out of the plantation & now live on during her widowhood &
 at her death or marriage the same to be equally divided between
 my sons Allen & William and their heirs forever the said
 last mentioned tract of Land containing two hundred
 and thirty one acres more or less being the same lot of
 Samuel Warler reference to the conveyance to myself the
 boundaries will fully appear I also will & bequeath to my
 said wife a negro girl named Leega if Leega die before myself
 will & bequeath to her a mother negro girl worth two hundred
 and fifty dollars. 4th I will and bequeath to my son William
 and in special trust for the Specie above Support and
