

Lunda Lee Will

In the name of God Amen I Lunda Lee of the State of
 Habana and County of Dallas being in good health and of
 perfect mind thank be given unto God Calling mind
 mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last
 Will and Testament that is to say principally and first
 of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of
 Almighty God that giveth life and my body I recommend to
 Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the
 discretion of my friends and as touching such worldly Estate
 wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this I give
 demise and dispose of the same in the following
 manner and form to wit. First I give unto my wife
 Pleasant Lee the following property to wit. Thirteen Negroes
 to wit. Namely Fanny Ket Parker Sam Martin Silma
 Fanny Sam Delsa Caroline Harriet Minerva and
 Ruffus and also all of my Beds and furniture and I also send
 unto my wife Pleasant Lee during her natural life time or
 widow hood the following property to wit Ben David Rubard
 Elior Belinda Millia Fames Robert Sulay and Lito and
 also all of my Lands and stock of all description and
 Crop and persons now on hand and forming lands
 Second it is my will after the death or Marriage of my wife
 Pleasant Lee that All my property which I have sent to my
 wife to be sold by my Executors to wit. Ten Negroes and all
 of my lands and stock of all description the plantation
 tools and the crop and all the Bedmen then on hand
 the lands to be sold and Credit my half to fall due at
 the Expiration one year and the other half at the Expiration
 of Two years and the balance of the property to be sold and
 Credit of One year and it is my will that the money arising
 from the sale of the above named property I divide equally
 divided among all my grand Children when they arrive
 to the age of Twenty one year that is to say that I wish my
 Executors to keep the money at interest in safe hands till the first
 arrives to the age of Twenty one years at which time I wish that
 one to recover their part and the balance to remain in the
 hands of My Executors at Interest as before until the
 second one arrives at the age of Twenty one year at which
 time that one to recover it part and in like manner till the
 whole arrives to the age of Twenty one years of Third give
 unto my daughter Elizabeth of fifty Dollars in cash
 and I also send unto my daughter Elizabeth of during
 her natural life the following property to wit Two Negroes
 to wit Tilly & Abilley one boy Labrus and three beds &

furniture and one half dozen Seating Chairs and if my
daughter Elizabeth Cor should have heir or heirs born
of her body to survive I give the above property to her
heir or heirs as the case may be and if my daughter
should have no heirs born of her body then in that
Case at her death the property to return to my Estate
Executors to be sold by them and the money divided
Equally among my grand Children. Fourth I give unto
my daughter Nancy Nance the following property to wit
four negroes to wit namely Hatty Jack Slipney & Ginny
three Beds & furniture one half dozen Seating Chairs &
also fifty dollars in cash. Fifth it is my will that my Executors
should do sell. Two of my negroes to wit Redick and Carter
and pay all of my debts and all other debts due. Expence
the balance of the money to be given unto my wife for her
to have dispose of a greivable to whom will or power.
Sixth it is also my will that all of my property that I have
not otherwise disposed of as also all moneys due and owing
unto me as well as all moneys on hand I give unto my
wife Pleasant Lee. Seventh and I constitute and appoint
Eaton Lee and Samuel Moore I do Executor of this
my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly
disallowe, revoke and disannul all and every other
former wills and Executors by me in any wise before
named Will's and bequeathed ratified and confirming
this and are other to be my last Will and Testament in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
Twenty Seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one
thousand Eight hundred and thirty Nine. Junda Lee Test
Signed & sealed and delivered by the said Junda Lee as his last
Will and testament in the presence of us whom his presents and
in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our
names Allen Moore Nathl Kimbrough Bryan
Trail Bearewell Kimbrough. The State of Alabama
Dallas County Personally appeared in open Court
Nathaniel Kimbrough one of the subscribing witnesses to
the foregoing Will who being duly sworn deposeth and
saith that he saw Junda Lee Sign seal and duly execute
said Will as and for his last will and testament that
said testator was of sound mind and disposing
memory at the time of executing the same and
that he this deponent Bryan Trail and Bearewell
Kimbrough and Allen Moore signed the same as
witness in presence of and at the request of said Testator
and of each other

Joseph Lawrence Will

In the State of South Carolina York District In the name
of God amen I Joseph Lawrence of the State and district
of aforesaid State being of sound mind & disposing mind do
make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner & to
form following &c. 1st I will & bequeath unto my son Allen the
tract of Land & lot of John Tamm containing about one
hundred acres more or less reference to the conveyance to myself
the foundations thereof will fully appear to him & his heirs forever
also one bed furniture & one Cow & calf & my negro girl named
Gianna & will her increase borne after this day & if Gianna dies
before Allen obtain the possession of her from me then her value
to be made up to him out of my Estate. 2nd I will & bequeath
to my son Allen in Special trust for the separate use & support
and maintenance of my daughter Frances during the
term of her natural life the following property to wit:
I make her daughter Sarah & her child now at this time
being a female & with the said negroes their future increase
born after this day & after the death of my said daughter the
said negroes with their increase to be equally divided among
my said child or children as the said Frances may
have living at the time of her death & these & are to be
like them & their heirs forever and should my said daughter
die without leaving such child or children alive at the
time of death then the said negroes with their increase shall re-
vert to my heirs at law & be equally divided among them &
their heirs forever should anake or his children or any of them
die before possession possessed from me the value then of
to be made up from my Estate under the same limitations
and restrictions as anake & her increase. 3rd I will and
bequeath unto my wife Martha her support and maintenance
out of the plantation I now live on during her widowhood &
at her death or marriage the same to be equally divided between
my sons Allen & William and their heirs forever the said
last mentioned tract of Land containing two hundred
and thirty one acres more or less being the same lot of
Samuel Warler reference to the conveyance to myself the
boundaries will fully appear. I also will & bequeath to my
said wife a negro girl named Leega if Leega die before myself
I will & bequeath to her a nether negro girl worth two hundred
and fifty dollars. 4th I will and bequeath to my son Will-
iam in Special trust for the special use support and
