of Dallas State of Alabama, Executors to this my
last Will and Testament.
Secondly, after paying all my debts and Charges,
I desire of my Estate as follows, that is to say,
Thomas I leave heretofore given to each of my Children
excepting my Daughter Virginia one Negro Man and
their increase, I leave give and devise to my said
Daughter Virginia, my servant Harlow and her Children
