"In the name of God Amen. I Nathan Thrash of the
County of Dallas and State of Alabama considering the
uncertainty of this mortal life and being of disposing
mind blessed by Almighty God for the same do make
and publish this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following viz. First I wish all my just debts
to be paid. Second I give and bequeath unto my loving
wife Patsy Thrash during her natural life or so long as she
the tract of land I now live on my negro girl Mary and
her increase with all my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs and
the grain I have and had with my cash that I have one
hundred in five all my estate at her Command for the
use of her self and family my wish is that my beloved
and wife should wish to remain elsewhere she will be
at liberty to sell the said tract of Land and purchase
Land elsewhere with the same money. I hereby appoint
my beloved wife Patsy Thrash & George W. Taylor my
Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby
revoking all other former wills by me made. In Witness I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this 28th day of April
1838. Nathan Thrash Read Signed and published
and delivered by the above named Nathan Thrash
to be his Will and Testament in the presence of us
who having heretofore subscribed our names as Witnesses in
the presence of the Testator. Andrew Yeast Charles V.
Kennedy Isaac Taylor. The State of Alabama Dallas
County Personally appeared in open Court Andrew Yeast
and Isaac Taylor two of the subscribing Witnesses to the
foregoing Will who being duly sworn depose and
swear that they saw Nathan Thrash the Testator sign seal
and execute that said Will and for his last Will and
Testament that said Testator was of sound mind and

William Wren's Will

I William Wren of the County of Dallas and State of Alabama being weak of body but of sound mind and understanding do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following viz. In the first place I give and bequeath to my son, during his natural life a wife and household, the following negroes Slaves viz. Elias and his wife Harriet, Ann Paddy, Amanda, Sarah, and the old woman Fanny and boys John and Randall; and at the death or marriage of my wife Sarah I give the above named Slaves to my son Richard W. Wren. Should my wife marry again she shall have and possess the girl Paddy during her natural life, should both my wife Sarah and my son Richard W. die before he (Richard W.) comes to the age of twenty one year, then the above named negro Slaves are to be equally divided between my children. Horrell Wren Polly, Glover Elizabeth, Mcmillian, Oppenies Ad and Milley Hot and Scanna. Mcmillian should my son Richard W. die before he comes to the age of twenty one year and my wife Sarah survive, then the above named Slaves at the death or marriage of my wife Sarah shall be equally divided between my children above named. I also the ready ~~made~~ money and money due to me at my death after paying my just debts, I give to my wife Sarah and my son Richard W. for their mutual support and the education of my son Richard W. who I desire shall have a liberal education.
