

Sally L. Webb Will

The State of Alabama Dallas County. In the Name of God
 Amen: I Sally L. Webb of the County and State aforesaid
 being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make constitute
 and appoint this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
 all other and previous Wills which I may at any time have made
 In the first place I give and bequeath to my Brother Thomas
 Webb my Tract of Land lying in the State of Mississippi adjoining
 his present residence and in case I should sell the same
 before my death it is my Will and desire that my Executor
 hereinafter to be named shall pay to him out of my estate the
 amount in Cash for which said Land may have been sold
 and I further more give & bequeath to my Brother Thomas
 my Negro boy George all of which said bequests shall be
 to him and his heirs forever. Secondly I Give and bequeath
 to my Brother Henry Webb my Negro Woman Mary and
 their children and the increase of the females thereof that
 may be in my possession at the time of my death also my
 money that the Mrs. owe me at the time of my Death and
 six thousand dollars in Cash to be paid by my Executors
 to him and his heirs forever. Thirdly I give to my Nephew
 Edward Webb son of John Webb my Slave John and his sons
 and Tings to him and his heirs forever, and in the event of his
 not surviving me then said Slaves and Tings are hereby
 bequeathed to my Nephew John Webb son of John Webb.
 Fourthly I give and bequeath to the Cumberland Presby-
 terian Minister that may be Pastor of the Vernon Church
 Dallas County if any at the time of my Death a full
 suit of black break Cloth Clothes to be paid for by my
 Executor out of my estate. Fifthly I give to my
 Brother John Webb all the remainder of my estate
 not herein before disposed of both real and personal
 together with all of my money that I may have on hand at
 the time of my Death (after paying off all of my just debts)
 also all debts that may be due me from himself or from
 any other source. I give and bequeath to my said Brother
 John Webb to him and his heirs forever: and I do
 hereby appoint, and constitute my said Brother John
 Webb, sole and only legatee and sole Executor of this my
 last Will and Testament, and it is further more my Will
 and desire that there shall be no appraisement of my estate
 and that the Court shall require no further security of my
 Executor than his own bond. In Testimony Whereof I have

I James C. Campbell of Dallas County State of Alabama
being indisposed in bodily health but of sound and disposing
mind and memory calling to mind the frailty and uncertainty
of human life and being desirous of settling my worldly
affairs, and wishing how the Estates with which it has
pleased God to bless me shall be disposed of after my
decease, while I have strength and capacity so to do, I make
and publish this my last Will and Testament.
Merely Revoking and Making Null and Void all other
last Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made.
First I Command my immortal Soul to Him Who gave it,
and my body to the Earth to be buried with little expense
and cost of Station by my Executors, herein after named
and as to my worldly Estate and all the property real personal
or mixed of which I may die seized, and disposed of to
which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease I
do give bequeath and dispose thereof in the manner following
I purport my Will is that all my just debts and funeral
Expenses shall by my Executors herein after named be paid
out of my Estate as soon after my decease as shall by them
be found convenient. Then I give devise and bequeath
to my beloved Wife Mary Campbell all my house hold
and Kitchen furniture together with the Stock & Horses
Wheats Haggens Cattle Hogs and provisions on hand &c.
