

Daniel Entwors Will

The State of South Carolina, Newberry District.
In the Name of God Amen, I Daniel Entwors of the State and
District aforesaid being of Sound and disposing mind and
Memory, but Weak in Body and, Calling to mind the uncertainty
of life, and being desirous to dispose of all such Worldly Estate
as it hath pleased God to bless me with. Do make and Ordain
this my last Will, in Manner following that is to say:-

I Desire that all the Crop now growing to be sold, except
so much as may be necessary for Support to be sold and also
all my Stock of Cattle, Sheep and Hogs, and all my plantation
Tools with so much of the House hold and Kitchen furniture
as may be necessary for the Comfort and Convenience
of my Wife to be sold, and all my Just debts and General Expenses
be paid, and should the above property prove insufficient for the
above purposes, then I Desire that my executor hereinafter to
be named may sell such other property as will suit her best sufficient
to pay said debts, and out of the money arising therefrom, pay
and satisfy such of my just debts as shall remain unpaid
out of the Sale of the property devised to be sold.

After payment of my debts and general Expenses, I Give
to my wife, Nancy Entwors all my Negroes being nine in
Number, Namely, Mariah, Diley, Simon, Paul, Lena, Darc,
Levi, Mary, Andrew, and also two head of horses two
Mules, one head of Cattle, and a set of harness and one four
wheel Carriage and Waggons as also all my other property both
Real and Personal, that may be left after payment of my
debts as before directed, for and during the term of her Natural
life. And Lastly, I do constitute and appoint my
said Wife (executing) Executor of this my last Will and Testament
by me herebefore made. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal This Twentieth
third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and Nine. Witness My hand, Daniel Entwors, 1809
Signed Sealed Published and Declared as and for the last Will
and Testament of the above named Daniel Entwors in the presence
of us Henry Woogren, John Woogren, Nick Hancock, William
Woogren, Wm. David Moore.
