The State of Alabama Dallas County I do now all
Men by these presents that I Sarah Thompson
of the County of Dallas and State of Alabama being
of sound mind and disposing memory do make
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annuling
all other and former Wills and Testaments by me at any
time made. First after the payment of all my just
debts and Funeral expenses I give and bequeath unto
the Children of my son William V Thompson and lawful
Widow his wife said William V Thompson being at
this time dead three good feather beds and furniture
in the same and two thousand five hundred dollars
in lawful money to be equally divided between said children
of his son William V Thompson. I do give specially
one set chair to a Sherriff and in case said children
should die before coming to lawful age or should die
without children in lawful wedlock, they shall then
the said two thousand five hundred dollars and
the said three good feather beds and furniture for
the same to go to my son Andrew Jackson Thompson

qua his heirs. Second I give and bequeath to my son Andrew Jackson Thompson my Pictures Carriage and Match of Horses together with the harness of my horses Mules and Stock of all Kinds also my house held and Kitchen & furniture Germany and Plantation beds and all personal estate property not otherwise disposed of and all Money on hand Notes Rights and Credit which I may have at my Death but otherwise disposed of. Third I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son Andrew Jackson Thompson Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In testifying where in I have placed before my hand and affixed my seal this 25th day of November AD 1843. The same sealed on Page 17th line thereof by signing and sealing also on the 25th day of November 1843 and 15th day of December 1843 by Sarah Thompson & her by L. B. Mosely & John A. Norwood, William Dennis.
