I Susan Elizabeth Hester Newell being

death and the uncertainty of the time in which it may

of my funeral expenses and doctor bill and all other debts  
now outstanding against me I give and bequeath a  
sufficiency of my little effects to the surviving of both  
lives over the grave of my father mother and brother

my dear friend and daughter according the same to myself

All the balance of the property I now am possessed  
of I give and bequeath to my Sister Sarah Hester  
to have and to hold as her own lawful property in person  
or by heirs or assigns forever moreover I do hereby appoint  
to this my last will and testament  
as executor to manage and settle after my decease all

in my concern after the form of the above instrument and  
accordig to her will I charge to God I Command my son  
to look and to Almighty appear

The Estate of Alabama Dallas County  
Personally appeared before me Thomas G. Rainier Clerk of  
the County Court in and for the County aforesaid Samuel  
M. Barnes and William A. Garrison who being duly  
sworn on oath deposed and sworn that the foregoing page  
of this shall of importing, to the last will and testament  
of Susan Elizabeth Weston was made at her request and  
read over to her by Abraham P. Olaf but it being about eight  
O'clock at night she stated that she would wait until morning  
when perhaps she would feel better and have a chance of  
reading it over herself and sign it, the above facts took place  
on the 3<sup>rd</sup> October 1840 and shee grew worse until she died  
which was on the 4<sup>th</sup> day thereafter

Jo, Schenck, Allen, Kate, Abram, Penelopie, Caroline, Cyrus  
Eliza, Henry & Corry & also I give and bequeath unto my son Francis  
the slaves herein after mentioned Item. I give devise and bequeath unto  
my son James S. Coleman the following negroes viz Ned Peter  
Cormandy old Peter Hopkins old Cal, Lundy, Ben Jacob Edward  
little Phillis and Prudy. I also give, devise, & bequeath unto my son  
James the lands herein after mentioned Item. I give devise and bequeath  
unto my son Lawrence Coleman the following negroes viz Hanina  
Emily Jenkins, Mary Jane, Lila, Charlotte, Alfred, Abby & Cornelius  
I also give, devise & bequeath unto my son Lauren all the lands he  
in after mentioned, Item I give devise and bequeath unto
