in the same way by all which is my wife Phoebe G.
Christian during her minority or it may stand
3rd I hereby implore my wife to buy and sell for the
benefit of my estate or the of my living all kinds
of property and to do all other acts and deeds which I
could or might to my advantage her minister
4th After the death of my children manage my will and direct
my wife to give off to them or her so much such prop-
erty or money as she may think fit and to take such
measures to secure it to them as I could or might do
now I living

5th Since my wife Phoebe G Christian die before any of
my Children marry then my property to be set up
beg this and manage for them as if she were still living
as one or the other arrives similarly or among them
they are to have an equal portion taken from my estate
so that the estate be kept together as long as possible
6th She last my wife manage her own affairs as she best
see to do as she pleased with, But it is not to be
subject to any debts only of her own contracting before
she die without issue by her second marriage then that
property she draw from my estate to road back to my

Children to be equally divided between them
In this Case my wife and before all my Children may
be given at the age of Twenty then I desire that being
it whether of Lawful minister to my estate and
marriage Part his discretion and that item is to empower
him to buy and sell such property as he may think
fit for the benefit of my estate

Also I do hereby appoint my wife Mary by will all my children
many or few at the age of Twenty then I desire that
Said Wm Gist her husband Doctor May with him specified in
This 2d day of the month of January in the management
of my estate to cause and determine what that time
I being with Confidence in my wife Maria Christian
I do hereby constitute and appoint her executors to
carry that my last will and testament into effect
without giving bond or security or making any return
to Court during her minority In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
