Arthur, Peggy & her child and Henry together with their Heirs and one
hundred & fifty dollars that be and are, and I also give unto Person Davis

their heirs. Also I give to Joseph Wm. Perry Collins that he can
see, and to the head of Sally Wm. Davis one negro girl named
feller named Robt. that I purchased of Person Davis one by name
Ginnah. One by name Robt. and one girl named Hannah together
with their heirs, and also I give unto Polly another my daughter and
her heirs one negro man named Sam. One by name Abel. One by
name William, and his children and one girl named Linnah together
with their heirs and one negro woman called in part of a debt that
my husband Joseph Walker owes me, and last of all at my death
wish all the Realities of my Estate to be sold and ready money
amongst all of my lawful heirs at the direction of my Executors,
and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and disannul all and every other
former Testament, wills, legacies, bequests and Executors by me in any
before named, written & Requeathed. Ratifying and confirming this
to be my last will and testament.
