and property has to be sold I prefer that Betty

other part of my estate <sup>also 3<sup>rd</sup></sup> that of my wife Emily to which she  
may have all of all of the house hold and Kitchen furniture she  
is welcome to such part of it as she may wish and the  
balance of any to be sold and the price made applied  
to the payment of my debts. <sup>also 3<sup>rd</sup></sup> that the  
remainder of my property after my debts are paid shall  
be kept and mortgaged together for the good of the Estate  
until either my wife Emily or my Daughter Eliza  
Leavens shall marry after which event if it should  
take place I wish and Equal division of the property  
to be made between the two <sup>also 3<sup>rd</sup></sup> that if any time it  
should be deemed to the advantage of my wife and daughter  
that the land at present owing by her should be sold.

I hereby will that it may be by the consent of my wife  
and the proceeds thereof be invested in other lands or  
negroes as may be deemed most expedient. <sup>also 5<sup>th</sup></sup>  
that if money should from any source be paid to  
the estate while it is kept together or any profits should  
arise from the land and negroes more than necessary to  
keep up the plantation, I wish said money be pro-  
vided to be invested in other lands and negroes and treated  
as part of the former property and worked with  
it. <sup>also 6<sup>th</sup></sup> that of this foregoing part of my  
will I leave Mr P Green of this State and County  
aforesaid, Executor. also <sup>7<sup>th</sup></sup> that the business  
of the several Merchantile firm in which I am interested  
viz Roper Reeder &c, and Roper & Reeder may  
be closed separately from my private affairs mentioned  
above, after which if there be any funds coming to me  
from that source I wish it to be paid over to the Ex-  
ecutor of the foregoing part of my will and by him  
appropriated as therein directed and upon his part  
of my will I leave Nathaniel Price of Lowndes  
County Alabama the Executor. On witness whereof  
I William F Roper the testator have by this my will  
written on one sheet of paper set my hand and seal  
this 24<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord
