

The report of sale of land belonging to the Estate of Jesse French, Deceased, is filed by J. L. French, Admr. The sale occurred on the 1st day of November 1858 and the buyer was Abraham Gross for the sum of \$356.50, payable 12 months, with S. C. Loyd and George Milton as his securities. The report is filed before John H. Norwood.

The sale list of personal property belonging to the estate of Jesse French included 1 log wagon, rope & chain, 1 cross cut saw, 1 adz, and 1 plow. Buyers were A. Gross and J. L. French.

The Appraisement of the property of the said Jesse French, deceased, is presented in Court by E. Guffey, E. N. Floyd and J. W. Daniel, Appraisers. Included were farm utensils, household items, 1 Rail Road certificate for eight shares (\$105.00), 50 acres of land with Saw and Grist mills (\$400.00). The total value was \$628.90.
