On the receipt of your letter
 & the proposed receipt for the Cotton (the 6 last bales) I
 went to the house of Harris & Roy/Kin & upon going next to the
 House owned by Harris & Burwell the names to the
 receipt you sent me - after examining them both that
 - aughly we could find no Cotton of your mark and I
 believe they did not receive any Cotton by that Boat
 there is no such house in Mobile as Harris & Burwell
 Harris & Roy/Kin are highly respectable & if they receive
 it would be accounted for immediately I have been to many
 other houses & Enquired for such a mark but could
 find nothing of it - The boat in which your
 Cotton seemed to have been shipped was here and
 discharged on the 5 April & the letter containing the

bill of lading to me was not written till the 10 of April &
 did not reach me until at least ten days after the Cotton
 was here and disposed of. I hope it may not be a loss to
 you I will still make further inquiries and hope if
 you can ascertain anything more about that you will
 write me & I will try to get it as the money if the
 Cotton is sold - Having seen no safe place to send
 I venture to send your money in out bills half by this
 & half by the next mail & when you get them you
 can pass them together this is the safest way you
 have but little doing in Mobile - The price of your
 Cotton is 1/2 or more than it would bring to day please
 write me when you get the last letter concerning the
 Cash We are not well Respectful yours Friend
