## SCHOOLS

The Board took into consideration the matter of the common school fund apportioned to this county for the year beginning July 1853 and also for the year beginning July 1854. We designate as places, New-nansville, Fort Harley, Micanopy, and Grange Creek and Fort Clarke, for a common school to be taught. That a school of three months be taught at each place. The teacher at Newnansville to be paid \$100.00. The teacher at Fort Harley to be paid \$75.00.

The teacher at Micanopy to be paid \$100.00 The teacher at Fort Clarke to be paid \$75.00. That the County Superintendent proceed to employ teachers as the law directs.
