General Remarks.

Plates 2 and 4 show maps of the cometern. The official map has been lost from the County Clerk's office; it was Tiled May 14, 1870 and indexed as Map 276. Plate 4 is a photograph of a map loaned by Treadwell Steers. the undertaker. The land occupied by the cemetery was in the possession of Henry Pountain for many years before the cemetery was opened. It is probable that there was some overflow of interments from the rear of Trinity Chapel Burying Ground and that a few lots were occupied before plans here drawn and a survey made for the comptery proper. Henry Pountain died lay 26, 1863, leaving as heire his children; Vincent Pountain, Mary L. wife content outlistopher, case wire of faul Merebreau, occas wire of John La-forge, and Buns Ann wife of Saucel Bayley, all of edult-age. The Fountain Cometery was probably formally opened in the year 1866. The first deeds for cometery lots from the heirs of Henry Pountain recorded in the County Clerk's office were dated January 1, 1866. The Pountain Cemetery Association was incorporated June 25, 1874. The names which show faintly upon the lote in Plate 4 appear in pencil upon the map and undoubtedly are the names of the lot owners. By reference to Plate 2, it will be noticed that an eastern section of the semetery is not shown upon the first map. This section contains single graves. Lots Nos. 162 and 163 are reserved for the entranse to the cemetery. There are two lots numbered 172 on the map. The numbers of the lots are sufficient guide to indicate to the reader the man-ner of transcription. As a general rule, whomever feasible the lots were transcribed from left to right, the same as the customery plan applied to the gravestones. 0. W. Buel was one of Staten Island's evrly gravestone dealers. He came from Connecticut and the first gravestones he furnished for Staten Island wer cut in Connecticut. His name appears as the stone cutter on a tablet in the front wall of the Reformed Dutch Church at Port Richmond, erected 1844-45. Subsequently Mr. Buel established his stone yard at Fort Michmond. His name often appears, as the stone cutter, on Staten Island gravestones. Mr. Suel furnished the Barrett monument and surrounding gravestones in the Barrett lot in the Staten Island Cemetery; see page 116. All these stones are engraved with raised letters and in their day must have been considered the finest in the cemeter:

M. G. Buell was a brother of O. W. Buel. The statements in this note were supplied in part by Horace E. Buel, son of O. W. Buel, who succeeded his father in the gravestone business.

General Remarks

This is the newer part of the Cemetery, which was opened in 1882. The older part occupies pages 33 to 51. Mr. Davis transcribed all the inscriptions taken in this part of the cemetery. The gravestones and lots were copied in rows running from south to north (left to right); unless otherwise noted, the gravestones and monuments face 35st towards Richmond Avenue. The majority of the monuments in the newer part of the cemetery are granite.

Nos. 1501 to 1510 comprise four rows in the large plot evidently laid feet east of lot 4 in the north-west corner of the plot; and No. 1510 is a few the south-east corner, close to the entrance to the commetry.
