In the Name of God Amen, I James Gee State of North Carolina, being
of Sound mind & memory but in a low state of bodily health (desiring to
settle my worldly Affairs before I receive the last summons of Nature) do
Dispose of them as follows: -

Imprimis It is my will that the widow Rebecca Gee shall enjoy & Possess my land
& Plantation lying in the County of Halifax & state aforesaid & all my Household furniture
During her widowhood; after the Expiration of which, the Land & Plantation to
Devolve to my brother Henry Gee, his Heirs & assigns forever
Item, I give & bequeath unto my said brother Henry One tract of Land lying
in Northampton County & state aforesaid to be the Property of him & his heirs & assigns

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Item, After my just Debts are all paid I give & bequeath to Martha
Jee Daughters of Chapel Gee; her heirs & assigns for ever, the whole residue
of all my real & Personal estate except what has been Disposed of as above
& I nominate & appoint my friends John Mues, Allen Jones, & James Martin
to be Executors of this my Last will & Testament. Given under my Hand &
Seal the day & year above written,
Signed Sealed, & Acknowledged
