

Some of this Orphans Court data has already been incorporated in previous pages to make for a single entry, & therefore is not repeated here. In other cases, & when there is some duplication, only the entry is retained which gives the best information.

Final accounts of Administrators are routine & therefore omitted here, likewise the petitions to divide Real Estate unless new heirs are mentioned, or some other new data.

When no parents are given for minors seeking a Guardian it can be assumed they are in their upper teens, yet under legal age of 21, & thus able to have a preference.

Other minors seem to be classified into two age groups - under age 14yrs, and above age 14yrs.
