The important point in this Schedule is the question in column 14, headed Disease or cause of death." Especial poins must be taken in this column to make the answer full and exact, and to this end, attention is called to the following points:

Enter the name of the primary disease in all cases, and where the immediate use of death has been a complication or consequence of the primary disease, enter that also.
