Ezekiel Bass Jr. was the son of Henry
and Francina Bass born Oct. 25, 1832
died July 4, 1898.

Henry Bass was the son of Ezekiel
Bass Sr. who was the first settler in the
Community where Watertown now stands, he
came to this State in the later part of the
eighteenth Century from the State of North
Carolina, he came from that state to this
in a Crude Conveyance composed of a tar-
wheel cart drawn by one horse, the trip
was long and perilous and little did he
know of the heritage he was to open up to
future generations.

He built a rude log cabin on the

bank of Round Lick Creek and applied to
it that endearing title of 'home'.

He was soon joined by two brothers
from whom have sprung the ^{many} large
generations of ~~the~~ Bass family.

Lewis Bass, present owner of ^{this} bible
was the son of Thomas Albert Bass
and grandson of Ezekiel Bass Jr.
