Dear Lucy;

I made my trip to Nashville yesterday and did not return last night until about ten thirty; therefore I did not get to mail this material to you until today.

I had copy made for you today of affidavit from my sisters, copy of each page of the Blackman Bible; you will note the holes pictured; where it was placed for safe keeping in the other Bible; you can see pin holes, if you look carefully on second page and on the pages of the inserted material; also fly page from the family Bible into which this was inserted.

I trust that this is the information they desire regarding the source of this information as far as Martha Louise having gotten it from my mother's Bible. In as much as it is late, I have forwarded to the Office of the Registrar General in Administration Bldg 1776 D Street, North West, Washington D. C. 20006- the same information. I shall enclose copy of note accompanying same. I did not have authority from you to do this and have tried to locate you today but I know you would like for this to be in Washington on Monday, if possible and this is the only way I see to do it. You may save this copy for your own papers; consider that Martha Louise are gone to Washington.

Would love to talk with you about this but you must be with the sick again.

We, Sadie Mae Kennedy and Willie Blackman Kennedy of 2220 West Ashwood Ave., Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee do hereby state that we were born on the 6th day of December 1889 and November 1st 1891, respectively, and that we are the daughters of the late Sarah Jane Blackman Kennedy Stringfellow and the late William Kennedy.

After the death of our father, William Kennedy, our mother married Robert Lee Stringfellow of Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee. By her first marriage my mother had one other child, namely the late Andrew Jackson Kennedy. Prior to moving to the above address we lived on River Road, about five miles from Nashville, Tennessee.

Our parents had a family Bible which was called the Parallel Bible, containing the authorized and Revised versions of the Old and New Testaments, arranged in parallel columns. This was published in 1887 in Philadelphia by A. J. Holman and Co., No. 1222 Arch Street. This Bible contained entries beginning with the marriage of our mother and William Kennedy on October 11th 1887. This Bible is owned jointly by the above named daughters, of Sarah Jane Blackman Kennedy Stringfellow and our other sister by my mother's second marriage, namely Jessie Eleanor Stringfellow Dilworth, wife of Dr. Thomas Elmor Dilworth of Huntsville, Alabama.

In the pages of the above mentioned Bible were four pages from the old Blackman Bible. These were placed within the above described Bible for safe keeping by our mother. On these pages were births, deaths and marriages. The four pages were filled. A true copy of these pages is attached. Some of these entries were in our mother's hand-writing. The words "These pages from Blackman Bible" are in our mother's hand-writing.

Our mother was very interested in her lineage and whenever she received or had information which she considered of value would work on her lineage in the Blackman family. As she grew older she found it easier to follow lines and therefore used ruled paper often. For safe keeping she placed in the above described Bible a short page of ruled paper with the names of her ancestors back to Stephen Blackman, born 1724. The entries on both sides of this paper are in our mother's hand-writing and we hereby state that the attached copy is a true copy of said page. This page was pinned between the second and third pages of these four pages. We also state that the copy of the four pages is a true copy of the pages from the Blackman Bible.
