Mrs. Leilia Stapler, wife of James S. Stapler, died at her residence in Tablequah Saturday evening, April 16, at 10 o'clock after an illness of three days. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. M. Hamilton, pastor of the Presbyterian church, at the residence Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, and the remains were interred in the city cemetery the same day at 4. Mrs. Stapler was 30 years old. She was born in New Orleans April 13th 1839, and was the daughter of Major and Mrs. N. B. Breelove who reside at Ogeechee. She was born there in Lynchburg, Va. and came to the Indian Territory in 1859. She taught school at Fort Gibson and afterward in the Female Seminary and was married to James Stapler September 27, 1861. Three children have preceded her to the great beyond. Mrs. Stapler was a member of the Presbyterian church in Tablequah and was an active worker for the cause of christianity. She has been identified with every charitable move of the ladies of Tablequah for many years past. She was willing and ready to lend her aid when good could be done for the poor, sick and unfortunate. Her death not only

MRS. URILDA BREEDLOVE SMITH

The death of Mrs. Urilda Breedlove Smith, who died yesterday, after a short illness, will be deplored by a wide circle of friends and relatives in this city. Mrs. Smith had attained the patriarchal age of 86 years, and passed all her faculties undimmed up to within a few hours of her end. She was a native of this city, and was born in October, 1810. Her father, Mr. W. C. Smith, was a man of prominence in his day, and was at one time collector of the Port of New Orleans. Her mother was a daughter of Genl. George Winchester, who commanded the American army at the battle of the Raisin, and was one of the pioneers of the State of Tennessee. Mrs. Smith married Isaac Wrightman Smith, a wealthy and prominent merchant of this city, who was at one time a member of the State Legislature and filled other important political offices. Mr. Smith died in England about ten years ago. Mrs. Smith's subsequent life was devoted to her children. She was a woman of rarely beautiful character, but possessed a kind and gentle ways. She leaves a daughter, Mrs. John E. Rodd, and a son Mr. Breedlove, of St. Louis, Mo., and several grandchildren.

The funeral will take place at 1 o'clock on Friday morning from the residence of her son-in-law, Mr. John E. Rodd, No. 2740 Chestnut Street. The friends of the deceased are invited to be present at the residence, but the interment will be private.

Miss Jennie Breedlove, well known in Tahlequah, died at Fairland Wednesday. Miss Breedlove leaves many friends and relations to mourn her demise. She had two sisters, Mrs. O. A. Smith, of Fairland, and Mrs. J. S. Stapler, of this place, and one brother, near Fairland. Her father and mother also survive her.

Mr Malinda Wilson wife of Wm Wilson, died Feb. 19-1864 aged 67. Daughter of William and Garrison Wharlon buried opposite Ft. Smith Ark. in the Cherokee Nat., by her husband. And a rough stone stood up marked Mr. Wilson. Remains taken up and put in Cemetery at Muldror in 1910 by Emily Breedlove

In his earlier days he possessed no small degree of influence with his people, by whom he was always held in the highest esteem, and who will sincerely mourn his departure.
