Col. Anthony Crockett whose recent death at Frankfort, Ky. has been announced in the public prints was a native of Virginia. He took a very active part in the war of the Revolution, and afterwards, in the Indian warfare of the West. In the last war with Great Britain, he also participated, in connection with the Kentucky volunteers that invaded Canada, and was present at the battle of the Thames, at滑铁卢, in the war of the Revolution, he assisted, says the Washington Globe, in taking a nine pound Cannon, which was subsequently captured by the British in the last war, at the surrender of Hull at Detroit. Col. Crockett was present on the Hawser at the capture of this Cannon from the British; and as a mark of Memorial, it was committed by Governor Shelby to the Artillery Company of the County in which Col. Crockett resided.
