My ancestor by the name of Rhinehardt lived in Weatherford, N.C. and the Love family lived in Limestone Springs, Tenn. The Rhinehardts came from Germany first stopped in Pennsylvania and later settled in North Carolina. One daughter, Ann Elizabeth Rhinehardt (she was called Nancy) married John Love and lived in Limestone Springs Tenn or Cove Creek, Tenn. three and one half miles south west of Limestone Springs. John Love owned the springs. Lyuetta Love born Feb. 1823, daughter of Ann and John Love married Dr. Peter S. Anderson; one other daughter either Harriett or Montha married W.R. Stallcup. A few months ago Mr. Stallcup was living in Franklin N.C.

I think John Love came from Virginia. The children of Ann and John Love were Sarah, Hamilton, Lyuetta, Luther, Martha, Harriett and "Doc". Hamilton, the oldest son went to California during the "gold fever," then went to Knoxville, Tenn. married and died in Knoxville, Tenn., Ann Elizabeth Rhinehardt Love's mother must be buried in Limestone Springs, Tenn. The Rhinehardts and probably the Love family were Lutherans. I know Lyuetta Love Anderson was a member of this church.

My grandfather, Dr. Peter S. Anderson born March 4, 1823 in Green County, Va. mother married three times last two husbands were Andersons, not related however, last husband George Anderson, two sons by last marriage, George and Peter, Cev. Anderson brother of peter Anderson lived and died in Peola Kansas.
