Marriage License or Bonds of Blount County, Tennessee.

from year 1785 to 1884, inclusive. I am a Minister of the Gospel and I, William Edmund Farnham, of Maryville, Blount County, Tennessee, 218 Bryan Street, aged past Seventy-two years, do hereby certify, affirm, and declare that I have carefully hunted for, and copied each and all the License or Bonds that I could find from the year 1785 to the end including the year 1884. These were in the old files, I did not compare from 1884 to close of 1889 with the recorded Book of License, as that is the first Book record we have, but simply the papers as they could be found. I further certify that I have tried to follow the spelling of the Clerk or go by the name as the party may have signed on the Bond or that the Clerk or person who performed the Marriage Ceremony, may have changed to when writing the endorsemment on the License. The Marriage License or bonds in many instances were mutilated, stained, faded or in such handwriting as to be hard to be correctly copied, have done the best I could, and claim to be able to decipher many difficult handwritings. I have been induced to do this work by the Society of the D.A.R. women of Maryville and Blount County, and because of the Historic Value of these unrecorded papers. Many I know were lost in the fires of our Court Houses in 1878 and again in 1906, and no doubt some were lost during the war of 1861-5. In fact I have seen our License unreturned and in private homes, that should be in the files. Some that are "Bonds" only, I have seen affidavits of record that they were married, as sworn to by the Party who performed the Ceremony. I was in hopes that the County would make and keep a Copy in their care, but so far they have failed to do so. Sworn to and signed as on 204 pages and numbered from 1 to 885 on and up to page 42, then 1961 to and including #4083. In the first 42 pages I found errors in alphabetical arrangements and duplications, so rewrote from #43 to 43 over and have also a page 231 in so that in fact there are 205 Typewritten Pages, with 20 copies to the page. This is on page 205 as now numbered. Finished on Oct 22 1884. Began on Sept. 15 1882. *Wm E. Farnham*
