Bogie Matthew H. of Bogie Castle and in bad health I make this my last will and Testament respecting my earthly Estate. It is not after my death I want to be decently buried in Columbia Cemetery during my life and wife Nancy and my son Mathias Graves and I want such a Head and Foot Stones put up at my grave like that at my wife's grave. Second I bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Bogie, and set apart for her forever the following property viz Two Negros Charles and his wife Ann, and all the Household and Kitchen furniture that she brought to my house when she came here to live. I also give her my gray mare Susie and my Cig. & Dog Lazarus, and about six headroom with new basket. Five Cows and Lambs two heifers and Calves and two yearling Heifers two Sows and Pigs and five years old Stock Dogs, and a number of the bedding about the House and Five hundred dollars in Cash to allow and authorize my Executors to pay over the above named sum to her, now in consideration of the aforementioned hermatrical property and sum to my wife Nancy & her relatives all their rights to absent to said will died being fully satisfied with and property going to her. I said Mary Bogie agrees to the above and I do that agreement is to proceed to make my distribution or division amongst my children and bequeath to my daughter Malinda Calburn Bogie. Malinda bogie John and herse girl Elizabeth and Mary and Leslie my next girl child I in mind a sum money my brother George Calburn Bogie and also her bedding and saddle and her Mutton Saddle her mother's Bursaw and Chest with all of his mother's clothes about the House one of China that is in my bed and four cut glass tumblers one set Silver Tea Spoons marked M. B. and one set Silver Table Spoons one small glass wood and a Large Specifying which also one Bible and her other Books her School Books and one feather bed and bedstead & Furniture. I give and bequeath to my son Joseph B. Bogie my late Negro Boy Allen and his wife Calburn and moreover girl Child called Rachel I give also to him my new saddle and bridle my Bay Billy yearling colt New Colt I give and bequeath to my son William Ramsey Bogie my black boy George and black girl Martha and also his little saddle and bridle one feather bed and Furniture and feather his spelling Book Testament and Bible I give and bequeath to my son Mathias the single my

black boy Alfred one tub and pail and wash girl called Silvia with me feather bed and Furniture and wash stand and also one small saddle and bridle one spelling book Testament and Bible - I give and bequeath also to my son Guilford, leather Bridle my leather and Bridle and leather saddle and Furniture one spelling book Testament and Bible, My wish and desire is all of my other property that is not otherwise disposed of shall may come into the hands of my Executors may be used or sold them as my Executors may think best and the proceeds of the same be equally divided between my daughter Caroline and my son (viz) Joseph L. Mcilvane R. Mcilvane & Guilford & of my interest Estate I want my lands sold in time and the Executors withholding the sale until the last installment is paid, my wish is that my sons Joseph Mcilvane & Guilford be sent to school to Columbia Academy until they get at least a good English education and if they seem promising and have a desire to Study the Law negroes and Study a profession then and therefore my wish is that their guardians shall attend to and see that they are kept at some College of good reputation and out of the State of these Negroes or part of Union Estate buy their boarding and for their education, my wish and desire is that the negroes that I have added to my estate shall be sold out to such persons as will treat them & my family honest that my wife been bound to do so, and keeps them for the time they may have them free of any expense to their owners. If any of my children shall die before they arrive at the age of twenty one years and leave no heirs then & will this property to be equally divided amongst my other children that may be living, viz Joseph L. Malinda Calburn & male progeny of Bogie to Guilford, to Bogie and Bogie shall also pay to Mathias & and Mcilvane R. Dwyer dollars such as consequence of these negroes being of the most value I request and appoint James Blaylock my executor for my daughter Malinda Calburn & request and appoint Major D. D. Garrison for my son Joseph L. I request and appoint Guilford Calburn Garrison for my son William R. and Mcilvane & and I request and appoint Major D. D. Garrison for my son Guilford L. Bogie I do appoint Guilford Calburn William G. Bogie William Calburn and James D. Blaylock my true and lawful Executors to carry out this my last will and Testament or as manager of them as may act in that capacity Maryland 1847

my wish I do award Civilian Cannon as Guardian
for my son William R. Boyle and request and
appoint John Ramsey Executor for my son
William R. Boyle. Joseph Boyle is to pay the above
named in due and fifty Cents to each of the other
children in consequence of the appearance of an
increase in his division of his Negro property

of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee being
of sound mind and memory as most and ordinary
this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
all other wills by me made at any time or in any
manner. First I direct that my funeral expenses and
all my debts be paid as soon after my death
as possible out of my money that I may be
possessed of or may just come into my hands of
my Executors, 2d To my wife of legitimate birth below
wif. Ann Lewis I give the mansion house we now
reside in and a good and sufficient support
of the sum wherein I now reside during the
term of her natural life with groceries and
bedding and other household and Kitchen
furniture in quantity sufficient for her use
support less the use of a suitable horse beast for
her to go or come or during her life
3d To Kisia Lewis widow and mother of my deceased son
Henry Lewis I give and bequeath the piece of land
or tract of land I purchased from Aaron Cappock
during his residence it being the same whereon
she now resides and at the expiration of her wife
outlive or my son George youngest heir arrives at
the age of twenty one years then they equally divide

the land or see it and equally divide the property between
the children of my deceased son Henry Elizabeth Ann Lewis
Sarah Jane Lanning Miller and Mary Lewis being
the only sons and daughters of my deceased son
George H. D my daughter Naomi Lewis to give me leather
bed and my milk cow - 5th To my son Samuel Lewis I
give and bequeath the sum of Fifty dollars.
6th To my daughter Anna and many Maids and servants
Pearl and bequeath to each of them the sum of
one dollar each I having partitioned these before
7th give and bequeath unto my son William Lewis the
plantation now lie in and the one lying adjoining
it purchase of Thomas Dyer with all my lands not
disposed of heretofore together with all my personal
property that is not heretofore in this my will I dispossess of
at my decease 8th and lastly I command and appoint
my beloved wife Ann Lewis and my son William
Lewis Executors and Executrix of this my last will
and Testaments. In Testimony I have signed my
hand and affixed my seal this twenty day of the
second month (February) in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty seven in
the presence of us
