 and requires it. Also my negro woman Lyma I give and bequeath to
 my two daughters Melly and Anne corner to be divided equally be-
 tween them when she becomes of age. Also the above mentioned Negro to
 be divided out with Anne becomes of age and the profits arising
 from the same to be equally divided amongst my five younger
 children. I will that my six youngest sons be put to school or the
 education of my education. Also the remainder of my personal
 good and Chattels of whatever kind not before mentioned to be sold
 and the money arising to be divided equally amongst my six sons W^m
