I do further will and bequeath to my daughter Ann Rutledge Agnes Hamilton Polly Boyd and Elizabeth Boyd each the dowry I have heretofore given them to the wife and bequeath to my son in law Samuel Hamilton my negro girl wife and her issue I do further will and bequeath that my heirs James John and David for and in consideration of the fidelity and obedience with which they have long served me enjoy their freedom after my death. I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Mathew Russell Esq. and William Gillespie Esq. my Executors to execute and carry into effect this my last will and Testament and I do hereby nominate and make all and every other will and Testament by me at any time heretofore made and do hereby ratify and confirm the same and no other my last will and Testament.
