2nd Secondly I give and bequeath to my son Keoni Chamberlain my bed and its furniture all the farming utensils together with the horse teams all my stock of hogs

3rd Thirdly I give and bequeath to my daughter Quincy Chamberlain my bed and its furniture one bedstead wash stand and one big pot one red kupa and one calf

4th Fourthly I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret Chamberlain my bed and its furniture one half of the land on which I live and one big cow one black side cow and yearling and I also give and bequeath to my two daughters Quincy Chamberlain and Margaret Chamberlain my negro girl Lilliah to be divided between them at any time that the master or mistress on their part of her value to my daughter Quincy Chamberlain and the other two thirds to my daughter Margaret Chamberlain and if the said girl Lilliah should have any children before a division should take place the first child is to be for Quincy Chamberlain and her heirs

5th Fifthly I will that the balance of my estate that is not herein provided for be sold by my executors and after paying all my just debts be equally divided between my six children Henry Gillespie Harry Wallace Quincy Chamberlain Keoni Chamberlain Sabel Colburn and Margaret Chamberlain

6th And it is my will that my two trusty friends William Walker and Peter Gillespie shall be executors of this my last will testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eleven
