I Samuel Creswell of the County of Blount and
State of Tennessee do make and publish this my last

with & dispose of the same as follows. First I direct
that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as
soon after my decease as possible out of my money
that I may be possessing of or may have come
into the hands of my Executor from any portion of
my estate real or personal, so entirely as give and
bequeath to my wife Nancy S. Creswell all the household
and other furniture that she was in possession of at
the time of our marriage likewise the gray mare that
is now in the farm called Queen and her foal
and to her & her master and her slave Cow and calf
I likewise will to her the money that she inherits in
her possession as her own & further will that she is to have
a comfortable subsistence while she remains on the farm
that we may live on and in the event that she removes
from said farm she shall be allowed twenty dollars
each year out of the proceeds of the farm such as grain
or &c &c for a sufficient subsistence during her lifetime
Secondly it is my will that the balance of my personal
property and the proceeds of the farm shall remain
in trust and subject of my widow during their
single life jointly & bequeath to my daughter Anna
Caroline and Elizabeth each one half thereof and next
