In the name of God Omnipotent I Isaac Hair of the State of Tennessee and County of Blount being dict and weak in body but finding my mind strong and my judgment sound blessed be God and calling to mind the frailty of man and the certainty of death do think it my duty and I do hereby make and constitute this my last will and testament to wit - I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elias Hitch the third part of the tract of land and plantation on which I now live including my dwelling house and all other necessary buildings the land to be so laid off to her by my executors as she will see most advantageous to her and that here forever by running the division line such reperent course as shall best suit the convenience of each part of my tract of land and if my wife should in future day think it better and best so to do she may give up her part of said land to the executors to sell with the other part of the land and the third part of the sale or money arising from the sale of all the tract of land be retained in the hands of my executors and if she wishes it to be layed out in the other lands and putting such in improvements on it as she may see fit if she wishes it money to be put on interest and the interest to be paid to her annually during her natural life I hereby nominate my executors to do so and after her death the money arising from the sale of her third of the land to be equally divided among all her children also I give and bequeath to my wife Elias Hitch 60 acr all my house hold and kitchen furniture also all my farming utensils all my live stock to either horses cattle hogs sheep &c to be used remain with her for her use and my children there now living with me to use my Son Joseph Elizabeth Eliza and Madison to use and distribute to them at Chilhowee as she may think proper and all my other estate to use all the means wherein me and others coming to me

and the money arising from the rents of the other parts of my land and plantation as it is my desire it should be received out into a common or open estimate & shall agree to sell it to advantage to all the heirs while it may be used to the endowment amongst my children and when due the money will be an account of the same and when due the money will be an account of the same after paying off just demands this may be against me I wish each divided amongst my children to wit my daughter Rachel Ruth my daughter Sarah Keppen my son Joseph Main my son Jacob their my daughter Elizabeth Main my daughter Maria Morrison my daughter Eliza & her husband Melson Main. Henderson to him for from time to time dividing his real estate to remunerate him for his kindness to me during my sickness if he is willing to take him at that price if not the boy Jacton to be sold by my executors for the most that he will bring the money that will be made out of my boy Jacton after paying off debts and expenses to be divided between Susannah and Stone and Mrs. Henderson and it is my will that every thing herein contained shall be divided among the said executors having an equal and lastly I do hereby appoint Mr. Andrew Lusk my executors of this my last will and testament another and making will and testamento of this my last will and every former will or testamento by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of August in the year of our Lord

SignedIn the name of God Amen I John Henderson of the County of Blount being sick and weak of body but of sound mind and disposing memory for which I thank God and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and being desirous to dispose of such worldly substance as I hath pleased God to bless me with I now dispose of the same in the manner following My 1st I desire that my land and exposed to publick sale and if it should not go at its valuation to be retained and either for rent or until it can be disposed of for its value2nd I desire that of my children Jane and George to be divided between them and the rest to my mother during her lifetime or until there may be other provisions made that is if David and Henry should be settled to themselves. And it was judged proper by my executors I wish them disposed of as shall be judged of more proper and I wish them to be educated or at least taught to read the word of God and in studies in the principles of morality and virtue and I desire that a cow go with each of the three sets of children if necessary and be replaced in a cow again as soon as possible when needed by the children and the clothing and bedding and such other household stuff and spinning tools as shall be considered needful be equally divided and managed for the children and I desire that my two sets of the oldest with Robert and the other with John to be reserved for them and put to their use and I desire that a calf such as one of these be provided for my property and I desire that the Calves be equally divided between them and the rest to my mother during her lifetime or until there may be other provisions made that is if David and Henry should be settled to themselves. And it was judged proper by my executors I wish them disposed of as shall be judged of more proper and I wish them to be educated or at least taught to read the word of God and in studies in the principles of morality and virtue and I desire that a cow go with each of the three sets of children if necessary and be replaced in a cow again as soon as possible when needed by the children and the clothing and bedding and such other household stuff and spinning tools as shall be considered needful be equally divided among my three brothers James Robert and Samuel Louisville executors of this my last will and testament hereby requesting all former wills by me written made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 2^d day of July 1823
