I Susannah Henderson of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee being advanced in age and knowing the certainty of death and believing it to be advisable to dispose of my estate while still with the enjoyment of my property and so hereby make this my last will and testamento in manner and form following 1st First I desire of my death that my body shall be decently buried and funeral expenses first paid next my just debts if there be any 2nd I give and bequeath to Susannah Henderson my daughter my dear Anna Maria and her child and her in trust if any forever 3rd I trust bequeath to my daughter Anna Gillispie my brother Peter and Alice 4th Next I give and bequeath to my wife Anna and Jose balance cash on her death bed and Clothing the last bed to be divided into three equal parts and given to Susannah H. Gillispie and Susannah Mr. Stone and Mary Henderson Mrs. First next bequeath to Jas Caldwell Mrs. one house bear unto fifty dollars in trade - Next bequeath to Susannah Mr. Stone all my Kitchen furniture the Cupboard and Side Dishes and the balance of my bed Sheets beds stockings and my own wearings clothes and all my household furniture not before this parcel of my negro Boys and Girls One Little Shop and some articles of every kind to be equally divided between Gillispie Mrs. Henderson and John Stone Agt I should not return I allow the Croft or hand to be equally divided between S and Gillispie and Mr. Henderson my large Kettle I give to Mary Henderson Mrs. my Boys by her son Peter W. Henderson to him for from summons desirous being taken of his real value to remunerate him for his kindness to me during my sickness if he is willing to take him at that price if not the boy factroy to be Sold by my executors for the most that he will bring the money than will be made out of my boy factroy after paying off debts and expenses to be divided between Susannah and Stone and Mrs. Henderson and it is my will that every thing herein contained shall be divided among the said executors bearing an equal and lastly I do hereby appoint Mr. Andrew Bain my executors of this my last will and testamento another and making such and such wills all and every former will or testamento by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of August in the year of our Lord

In the name of God Amen I John H. Bain of the County of Blount being sick and weak of body but of sound mind and disposing memory for which I thank God and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and being desirous to dispose of such worldly substance as is hath pleased God to bless me with I would dispose of the same in the manner following My 1st I desire that my land and interest to publick Sale and if it should not go at its valuation to be retained and either for sale or can be disposed of for its value 2nd I desire that of my children Jane Robert Patterson give my Brother Hoga and the rest to my Mother during her lifetime or until there may be other provisions made that is if David and Henry should be settled to themselves. And it was judged proper by my executors I wish John Nancy and Peggy as to Henry and the others to David but if it is not judgment proper I wish them disposed of as shall be judged of more proper and I wish them to be educated or at least taught to read the word of God and instructed in the principles of morality and virtue and I desire that a cow go with each of the three sets of Children if necessary and be replaced in a cow again at their same value when needed by the Children and the Clothing and bedding and such other household stuff and Spinning truck as shall be considered needful be equally divided and managed for the Children we and I desire that my two sets of the oldest with Robert and the other with John to be reserved for them and put to their use. and I desire that a Cellar seat as one of them be prepared for James out of my property and raised for his use and I desire that the Cabinet furniture be equally divided between Henry and James and that my Clothing be divided among such of my brothers as the may suit and their value replaced to the Children in such things as they may need. And next I desire that so many of my just debts as can be discharged out of my property and all others with my money that may arise therefrom and all property that remains exposed to Sale and the money arising therefrom together with any money that may remain in possession after paying my just debts and funeral expenses be equally divided among my four Children as the may arrive to years on a station of life to meet it Lastly I do hereby appoint my three brothers James Robert and Samuel Louisville executors of this my last will and testament hereby requesting all former wills by me hitherto made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 2^d day July 1823
