I do give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary her living of the land which she lives on - Contiguous in a State of Union bond, and also after my debts are paid, and the installments on the land are paid, I allow her one fourth part of the money of the money that is now due the Estate and at day fully I do bequeath to my son John Houston one half of the land at now live on, and one fourth part of all the money due the Estate after my debts are paid, and the installments on the land paid - I do give to my son Samuel Houston one half of my land at now live on, and one fourth part of the money now due the Estate after my debts are paid, and the installments on the land paid, also my wife Mary and a note on Samuel Rogers and George Davis for one hundred and forty dollars he paying his brother John ten dollars out of the last mentioned note. I do bequeath to my son Joseph one third part of the value of the land at now live on as he paid by John and Samuel. Equally for the land being left to him and one fourth of the money due after my debts and the installments paid on the land. I do give to my son in law John Maby one hundred and forty dollars one hundred out of the money that he owes me for the land and he owes on and forty dollars to be paid him by John Maby in consequence of a note at John Maby. I do give to my son in law John Maby one hundred out of the money he owes me for the land he lives on. I do allow the remainder of my property to be sold or sold at the discretion of my Executors and to be equally divided between Peggy, Polly, Daisy, Fanny and Betsy. Lastly I do appoint my son John Houston, my brother James Houston and my nephew James Henry the Executors of this my last will and testament. I do make and publish this my last will and testament. Surely nothing and making void all other wills by me at any other time made. My will and bequests are as follows. To wit first my funeral expenses and all my other just debts to be paid as soon as is convenient after death out of the first moneys that may come into the hands of my Executors. Second I do give and bequeath to my sons Robert and David Thompson ten dollars each and also to my son Thompson forty dollars, also to my daughter Phoebe Ann McFishing forty dollars, also to my daughter Betsy Henry twenty dollars, also to my daughter Darcus Nelson one horse, best, his choice of my stock and a pair of saddle that she has been in the habit of using, and also one good bedstead, and to my son - I do give and bequeath to my son Samuel Thompson a certain tract of land, situated to me by William H. and David Carson, as twenty acres off of the tract of land, situated to me by Hugh Cunningham to be laid off joining the Carson tract in the south side of the Cunningham Road the line to run straight from said road to Patrick McFishing line, parallel with the line of said Carson tract so as to contain the said twenty acres.
