1<sup>o</sup> all whom these presents may come or be made Known Know  
you that I Johnston Jones Senior of the County of Blount and State  
of Tennessee being weak of body but of sound mind and desiring  
Memory and Calling to mind the uncertainty of my body as in late  
ordain and constitute this my last will and testament in form and  
manner following as it is my will that my just debts and funeral  
expenses be paid out of my personal estate

2<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath to my son John Jones my Wagon on his  
paying what remains due and unpaid of the price thereof

3<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy Jones the plan-  
tation whereon I now live during her natural life or widow-  
hood 4<sup>o</sup> in the death or marriage of my wife Nancy Jones it  
is my will that the plantation whereon I now live be divided by  
a line running as was the middle of the ledge of Rocks that pass  
as through it as can be ascertained the South division of  
said land I give and bequeath unto my son John Jones his  
heirs and assigns forever the South division of said land I  
give and bequeath unto my said Son Johnston Jones to him  
his heirs and assigns forever.

5<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath unto my sons James John and John-  
ston a lot of woodland lying in the Woods to be equally di-  
vided between them to have their heirs and assigns forever

6<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughters Betty and Rebe-  
cca Jones a lot of land I own on Holston river lying between  
them and at their deaths to my Grandson William Jones son  
of my Son Samuel to him his heirs and assigns forever

7<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath to my Son Samuel Jones and my daughter  
Martha Jones one dollar each to be paid out of my per-  
sonal estate 8<sup>o</sup> the residue and remainder of my personal es-  
tate I give and bequeath unto my wife Nancy Jones and my  
daughter Betty Rebecca Nancy and Jane Jones to be equally  
divided between them after the settling my daughters Frances  
McCally's portion with what she has already got equal to her  
Martha being got her before

9<sup>o</sup> I do hereby ordain and constitute my Sons John Jones  
and Johnston Jones with my wife Nancy Jones executors of  
this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former  
wills by me made and constituting this and this only my  
last will and testament in testimony whereof I have here-  
set my hand and seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of the Sixteenth month 1831

I know all men by these presents that of Francis Jones of the  
County of Blount and State of Tennessee being laboring under  
much affection and bodily weakness yet of due passing mind and  
memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and con-  
tinuity of death as mortal and certain this as my last will  
and testament hereby revoking or making void all other wills  
herefore made by me, be it my will and desire that all my  
just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate

in the first place 2<sup>nd</sup> I will and bequeath to each of my brothers  
and Sisters Thomas Jones, Isaac Jones, Alard Jones, Margaret Jones  
and Elizabeth Ellis one dollar as a token of affection and remembrance  
they each being situated remote from me. Thirdly I will and bequeath to  
my other brother David Jones and Sister Nancy Jones the remaining  
part of a thirty dollar note that I hold on my brother David after  
paying to my alone named brothers and Sisters one dollar each out  
of my David note to be equally divided between them part and  
part alike that is one half of the remainder of said note to David  
Jones and the other half to Nancy Jones, my younger brother and Sister  
that are with me as a party remuneration for their time care and kind  
attention during my many afflictions. Fourthly I will and bequeath  
after the foregoing legacies and expenses are paid out of my estate  
all and every thing there may in any wise belong to me appertaining  
to my estate entering King and loving Nether Rebecca Jones to design  
super at my decease and hold the same as her own or as soon  
after my decease as my affairs can be settled up by my executors  
at law having disposed of the Woods abovesaid a Deed Proved here  
before me in the way and manner in which is agreeable to my  
mind. Lastly leave my brother Isaac Jones and David Jones  
my executors to this my last will and testament. Signed  
Sealed and published this the 12<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Month 1834 in

of Tennessee hereby makes my last will and testament in  
manner and form following that is 1<sup>o</sup> I desire that my real estate  
be immediately sold after my decease and out of the money  
arising therefrom in the first place my just debts all to be  
paid and 2<sup>o</sup> I give to my Son Andrew Jackson Thirty five  
dollars to be paid in March 3<sup>o</sup> I give to Samuel could Thirty  
five dollars also to be paid in March 4<sup>o</sup> I give to James Logan  
one half the balance of the price of my land after the above  
mentioned is paid 5<sup>o</sup> I give to my daughter Mary and the  
remainder of the price of the land and also all my house-  
hold furniture also all my money and utsils and bonds  
and all other of my perishable property and lastly I do  
hereby constitute and appoint my friends James Droll and  
John Dunlap executors of this my last will and testament here-  
by revoking all other or former wills and testaments by me hitherto  
made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
Seal this thirtieth day of June and in the year of our Lord  
1814, John Jackson Seal
