In the name of God Alme of William G. Lyle of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee as make and ordain this my last will and testamant. First that all my just debts be paid and funeral charges I give and bequeath to my wife Jane Lyle all my Stock of Cattle Hogs and Sheep all my household and kitchen furniture to be wholly at her disposal also all my books I give and bequeath to my oldest Son John E. Lyle my plantation on which I now live One hundred acres and my tools and farming utensils. Only that he is obligated to support his mother Jane Lyle during her natural life. I give and bequeath to my Son William one hundred dollars to be paid to him by my Son John E. Lyle when said William M. Lyle is twenty one years of age also to my Son Alfred M. Lyle two hundred dollars to be paid to him when he comes of age by my Son John E. Lyle also to my daughter Mary and son Lyle one horse and saddle valued at Twenty five dollars. These three last bequests are to be paid by my Son John E. Lyle in account of the legacy I gave him. And lastly I appoint and constitute Elizabeth H. Shadburn Executor of this my last will and testament witness my hand and seal 28th day of June 1834.

In the name of God Alme of David Logan of the State of Tennessee and County of Blount being sick and weak of body but of sound mind and disposing memory for which I thank God and calling to mind the uncertainty of human life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldly substance as it has pleased God to bestow me with I give and bequeath the sum in the manner following that is to say first I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Hannah one third of all my estate both real and personal for and during the term of her life and after her death I give the same to my children herein after named and to her my beloved wife the remaining two thirds of all the books and household furniture to dispose of the same at her own pleasure to make up any deficiency to either of the party as there be any except one bed and furniture Books and Clock the books at her death to be equally divided amongst all the legatees. Secondly to my fair beloved daughter Hannah R. Rachel Elizabeth and Peggy Ann the three youngest a portion equal to the oldest she having received all at and shortly after her marriage except five dollars which is now bequeathed to her to be discharged in good trade to Peggy Ann twenty two dollars in Good Trade to Elizabeth and Eight dollars in Good Trade to Rachel two dollars in Good Trade. these three last bequestsments are intended necessary to make the three youngest equal to the eldest in what she receives previous to her marriage. the also to have their portion exclusive of this as above stated third to my beloved grand daughter Priscilla Thompson if living to the age of eighteen a two year old heifer and five dollars in money fourth to my beloved grand daughter Priscilla Logan a good year old heifer fifth to my beloved Son Eli and Logan I give

I give and bequeath ten acres of land with a small improvement made by Robert Mcnelly on the same being part of the tract he now holds and eight dollars running for his land. Sixth to my beloved Son James R. Logan thirty Seven dollars which gave him in assisting him in paying for his land. To my beloved Son David J. Logan two Dollars in money and thirty Three in Trade owing for his land.第七 to my beloved Son John H. Logan any negro slave house which he has claimed a right to the feather bed above except the farming utensils the farm also at his mother's decease. and lastly as per Constitution and agreement the Friends Mr. and Mrs. James R. and David J. Logan Executives of this my last will and testament hereby certifying all this is their will or testament by me written made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this eighth day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty Six
