First I give and bequeath to my son Joseph B. Logan my plantation on which I now live together with all my farming utensils one yoke of Oxen one bed bedstead and furniture I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Love my horse to be valued to the value of one hundred and fifty bushels of Corn from the fall in the fall said horse and is to be paid my said daughter by my son Joseph B. Logan in consideration of his part of my estate left as above said horse was to be paid within the limits of eighteen months to my son John Logan my large Bible. I have purchased my daughter Sally McAllister Martha Love and my daughter Betty Love and my son James Logan to each of give and bequeath five dollars in any kind of property out of my estate to my three daughters from the Logan children of Logan and from McLogan I give and bequeath in horse now in my possession

on my stock of cattle and one horse with all my household and kitchen furniture to be equally divided among my said daughters viz Mary McLogan, Margaret C. Logan and Sally McLogan. If my said daughters care not agree in the division of said property my executor shall appoint two disinterested men to make said division and make certain to and appoint my son Joseph B. Logan and John Calkins executors of this my last will and testament. I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and this fifth day of March 1837.

In the name of God Amen I James Logan of Blount County and State of Tennessee being in firm of body and of perfect mind and memory do the day and date of these presents make and declare this my last will and testament as contained in the following Devises (viz) Devise 1st I give and bequeath to my wife Betty my dwelling house and all my household furniture except one bureau and one bed and furniture also I bequeath to her one Dorset Stead Colt two years old and two Cows and to have so much of the Benefit or profits of the farm on which I live as will support her her lifetime free from want all of which Devise I make after her death to my son James Logan and that during his minority he continue to live on my aforesaid farm with liberty to use my farming utensils wagon and work horses on said farm to the mutual Benefit of both my wife and said son Devise 2nd I give and bequeath to my son James Logan all the real and personal estate whether real or personal as well the debts due and owing to me as those before mentioned out of which I will that all my just debts be fully paid to effect which part purpose I fully empower and authorize my executor or executors herein appointed to exercise a full and entire power in selling any part or the whole either at public or private Sale a tract of land in Monroe County on which the heirs of Joseph Logan now live and for which premises I am now at law and in the event of recovery said land I also empower it on my executor or executors to exercise the aforesaid his ordinary power with due regard to the best interests of said legatee to conclude to carry into effect the aforesaid devise I hereby authenticate and approve my wife Betty and Andrew Logan my executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my Seal and subscribed with my own hand this first day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven.
