to be paid her out of my Estate as soon as it can be
settled out of the 5 all of my property then my Estate to
be equally divided between her and my three children
and is transferring my lands I mean as soon as an office
is opened for lands South of Franklin Board and Cotton
that money be a general out of my Estate and
my lands divided for the sole Benefit of my
wife and children to be equally divided among
them or if any of them should choose to keep the
land then they are so choosing shall pay to the
others their equal dividends in portions equal in value
to them by the land, stone & labour my brother
Daniel Bauer one hundred and Pounds it being due to
him out of monies that I have for his labour and due
for our land in Pennsylvania to be paid when the
money can be collected for said debt but it is
not my intention that he shall have it or any
part thereof out of my Estate and if it should so
happen that the said monies cannot not be had
then in that case he must take his part and I
do also recite all other wills and testaments and
deed and this my last will and testament I
witness whereof I have written set my hand and
seal this fourth day of December in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety eight.

I Alexander McAdam of Blount County and State of Tennessee
do make this my last will and Testament in manner
following that is to say 1st first all my just debts be
fully paid & after this discharge of my funeral
expenses that my beloved wife Phoebe McAdam have and
receive in full possession of the one third of all my
estate both real and personal that is in Blount County
during her widowhood and after her decease remaining
I give and bequeath to my child as hereinafter named
in manner following 2^d my will is that my negro
man John slave and my girl Malinda slave shall
be and remain on the premises where I now live
for the purpose of serving and working there and
my wife during her widowhood 3^d my will is

that my three sons Harry Al McAdam and Joseph Bauer
McAdam and James Davidson McAdam shall have each an
equally interest in four hundred and ten acres of
land of which I am possessor lying and being in Blount
County and also my three daughters named small slaves
an equal interest in the land John slave and also a
equal interest in a negro boy slave named Zacharias
4th that my daughter Mary Elizabeth McAdam shall have
a yellow girl slave named Lucretia and also a good
horse saddle and bridle and a good and sound farm
team 5th that my Sarah Malinda McAdam have my
yellow girl slave Lucretia and also a good horse saddle
and bridle and good bed and furniture
6th that my two daughters Mary C. McAdam and
Sarah McAdam in equally interest my girl Malinda
slave and her in excess 7th I do hereby constitute and
appoint my beloved wife Phoebe McAdam and James
Miller and James Cockrill 3rd Executors of this my last
will and Testament hereby revoking all other his former
wills or testaments by me made before made in
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this eighth day of February 1848

as a Codicil to my will and Testament is made as
my daughter Polly intermarried with Samuel
McAdams said marriage going to said daughter
Polly McAdams her impermissible past and said Samuel
McAdams and Polly his wife had one daughter named
Nelly Ad. McAdams who married Harry Cockrill
who all sa has received considerable amounts my wife
is that the said Harry Cockrill and wife Nelly
and my grand daughter have the sum of
five dollars to be paid at the discretion of my
executors hereinunder & set my hand and seal
this eighth day of February 1848

distributed my self to 8 acre and it is further my will
that John Montgomery and John Lowry shall be my executors
of my last will and Testament from the day of my death this thirtieth
of September 1848
