

I William Scott of the State of Tennessee (Blount County being far advanced in life but of a sound mind and a disposing memory and being desirous to dispose of that untidy goods which it has pleased God to bless me with as constant nurse and appoint this my last will and testament as ailing and making all other wills or testaments as ailing and making all other wills or testaments as ailing

1st It is my will that after my death my body shall be buried in a decent Christian like manner as my family shall think proper - 2^d That my just debts and funeral expenses shall be paid as soon as practicable

3^d It is my will that all my Estate real and personal shall be well remaining in the hands and under the control of my wife for her support during her life

4th It is my will that at the death of my wife that all the Estate that may remain then in the hands of my wife shall be equally divided between my daughter Mary Ann my

Grand Son Joseph C. Scott - 5th It is my will and desire that my friend and neighbor George W. Smith shall execute this my last will by which he shall have heretofore set my hand and seal this 27th day of July 1835

Witness my hand and seal this 27th day of July 1835 in the presence of us who in the presence of the testator and at his request have set our names as witnesses to the same

Know all men by these presents that I Gordon White of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee of sound mind and disposing mind and memory but being aged and infirm of body and realizing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death and being desirous when it shall please providence to call me home of having satisfactory arranged and settled all my temporal affairs do for that purpose hereby make and publish my last will and testament - 1st I will and bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my body to the earth to be decently interred

2^d I will and bequeath that after my decease my funeral expenses and all my just debts shall be paid

3^d I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Ann White my Negro Slave Julia to be by her disposed of as she may think proper I also bequeath to her the proceeds of the one half of the farm upon which I now reside to remain in year after my decease and to have and enjoy the same during her natural life - 4th I also will and bequeath to my said wife Ann my Sharp, three milk cows, also one horse

5th I will and bequeath the right and title of my Negro Slave Person to my Executors herein after appointed and the Survivors or Survivor of them and the heirs of the said Person to hold said Negro Girl Slave and her increase in trust for the sole and exclusive use and benefit of my daughter Abby Ketchum during her natural life and to her children after her death I also will

and bequeath that my said daughter during her natural life and her children after her death shall have and enjoy the possession of said Negro Girl Person and her increase if any - 6th I will and bequeath to my daughter Margaret Reynolds and Sally Anderson the portion of her inheritance I have advanced to each believing myself to have sufficiently provided for them - 7th I will and bequeath to my daughter Ann K. Boudin one Negro Slave named Spencer heretofore transferred to the possession of her husband John Kruster

8th I will and bequeath to my daughter Ephraim White a Negro Girl named Caroline also one horse saddle and bridle also one hundred dollars in money also three feather beds and furniture and that she and said Negro Girl shall during her life or while she remains single live up on and be supported from my said farm

9th I will and devise to my son John White the tract of land upon which I now reside to have and to hold the same with the tenants and to him and his heirs forever reserving nevertheless the proceeds of said farm for my said wife Ann White during her natural life as provided in the third bequest of this will I further will and bequeath to my said son John three Negro Slaves Nelson Charles and Clayborne I further will and bequeath to my said son John all my farming utensils my blacksmith shop and tools my wagon and harness also my library

10th I will and bequeath all my household and kitchen furniture not here before disposed of to my said wife Ann White I will and bequeath that my Negro Girl Jennina shall in consideration of her honesty and fidelity be permitted to make choice of which of my children she will live with and that she take with her her child Campbell which said Slave I bequeath to which

son of my said Child my said Negro Girl shall choose to reside with as afore said - 11th I will and bequeath to my said son John White after the payment of all my just debts all my personal property of late and being kind and disposition not herein before specially bequeathed - 12th I will and devise that my friends John White, Robert Porter and Campbell Hollospit shall execute this my last will and testament and do by these presents constitute and appoint them my Executors for that purpose publishing and declaring this my last will and testament hereby revoking and annulling any other former wills and testaments by me at any time heretofore made. The testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13th day of February 1835
